### Song #1 – Christ Alone

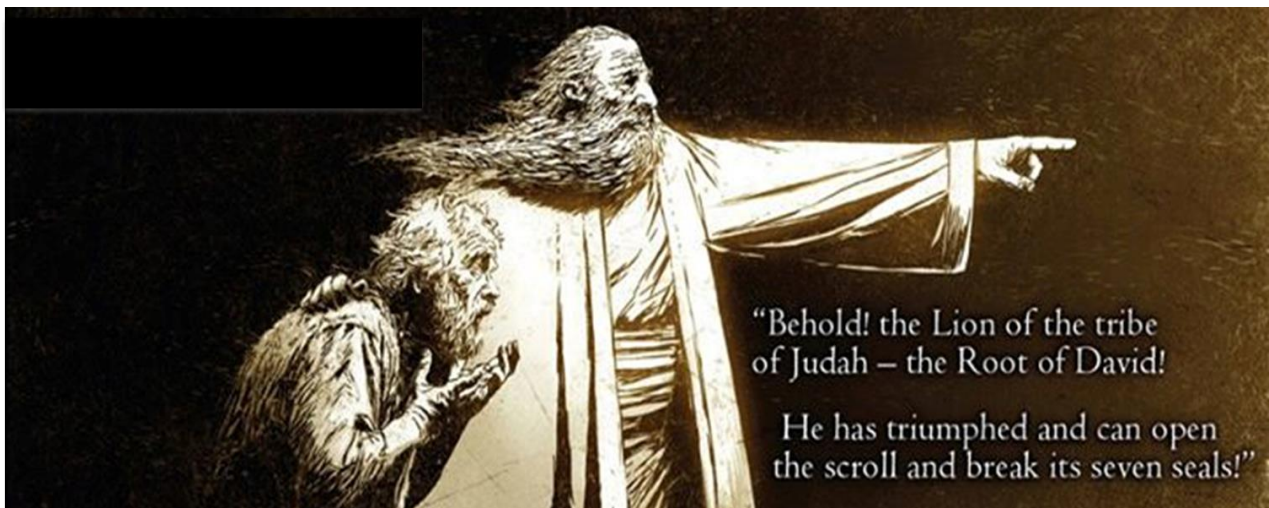
Chorus:

## How do we worship at home?

In “spirit and truth”

**John 4:23-24** <sup>23</sup> But the hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for the Father is seeking such to worship Him. <sup>24</sup> God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth.”

## Jesus was “in Spirit”

**Luke 4:18-19** <sup>18</sup> “The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me,  
Because He has anointed Me  
To preach the gospel to the poor;  
He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted,[j]  
To proclaim liberty to the captives  
And recovery of sight to the blind,  
To set at liberty those who are oppressed;  
<sup>19</sup> To proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord.”.
