## Marriage is a covenant

**Ephesians 5:31** Therefore a man shall leave his father and mother and hold fast to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh.

## Marriage refers to Christ & church

**Ephesians 5:32** This mystery is profound, and I am saying that it refers to Christ and the church.

### Love and respect

**Ephesians 5:33** However, let each one of you love his wife as himself, and let the wife see that she respects her husband.

agapao - selfless, sacrificial, unconditional love Phobeo - fear, afraid.

#### What is this love?

**1 Corinthians 13:4-8** <sup>4</sup> Love is <u>patient</u> and <u>Kind</u>; love does not envy or boast; it is not arrogant<sup>5</sup> or rude. It does <u>not insist on its own way</u>; it is not <u>irritable</u> or <u>resentful</u>; <sup>6</sup>it does not rejoice in wrongdoing, but rejoices with the truth.<sup>7</sup> Love <u>bears</u> all things, <u>believes</u> all things, <u>hopes</u> all things, <u>endures</u> all things.<sup>8</sup> Love never ends.

John 14:15 If you love me, you will keep my commandments.

1 John 3:18 Little children, let us not love in word or talk but in deed and in truth.

1 John 4:18 There is no fear in love, but perfect love casts out fear. For fear has to do with punishment, and whoever fears has not been perfected in love.

# What is this respect?

**Proverbs 15:33** The fear of the LORD is instruction in wisdom, and humility comes before honor.

**Proverbs 16:6** By steadfast love and faithfulness iniquity is atoned for, and by the fear of the LORD one turns away from evil.

### Disciple all children in obedience and honour

**Ephesians 6:1-4** <sup>1</sup> Children, <u>obey</u> your parents in the Lord, for this is right. <sup>2</sup> "<u>Honor</u> your father and mother" (this is the first commandment with a promise), <sup>3</sup> "that it may go well with you and that you may live long in the land." <sup>4</sup> Fathers, <u>do not provoke</u> your children to <u>anger</u>, but <u>bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord.</u>

Revelations 3:19 Those whom I love, I reprove and discipline, so be zealous and repent.

Matthew 19:19 Honor your father and mother, and, You shall love your neighbor as yourself."

### Disciple our children to bear much fruit

**John 15:8-12** 8 By this my Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit and so prove to be my disciples.

<sup>9</sup> As the Father has loved me, so have I loved you. Abide in my love. <sup>10</sup> If you keep my commandments, you will abide in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commandments and abide in his love. <sup>11</sup> These things I have spoken to you, that my joy may be in you, and that your joy may be full. <sup>12</sup> "This is my commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you.

#### Do we trust in man?

**Jeremiah 17:5-6** <sup>5</sup> Thus says the LORD: "Cursed is the man who trusts in man and makes flesh his strength, whose heart turns away from the LORD. <sup>6</sup> He is like a <u>shrub</u> in the desert, and shall not see any good come. He shall dwell in the parched places of the wilderness, in an uninhabited salt land.

#### Do we trust in LORD?

Jeremiah 17:7-8 7 Blessed is the man who trusts in the LORD, whose trust is the LORD.

<sup>8</sup> He is like a <u>tree</u> planted by water, that sends out its roots by the stream, and <u>does not fear</u> when heat comes, for its leaves remain green, and is not anxious in the year of drought, <u>for it does not cease</u> to bear fruit."

## We can be wrong?

**Jeremiah 17:9-10** <sup>9</sup> The <u>heart is deceitful</u> above all things, and desperately sick; who can understand it? <sup>10</sup> "<u>I the LORD search the heart and test the mind, to give every man according to his ways, according to the fruit of his deeds."</u>

#### Ask the LORD to heal us

**Jeremiah 17:13-14** <sup>13</sup> O LORD, the hope of Israel, all who forsake you shall be put to shame; those who turn away from you shall be written in the earth, for they have forsaken the LORD, the fountain of living water. <sup>14</sup> Heal me, O LORD, and I shall be healed; save me, and I shall be saved, for you are my praise.

#### Trust in the LORD with all our hearts

**Proverbs 3:5-8** <sup>5</sup> <u>Trust in the LORD with all your heart</u>, and do not lean on your <u>own understanding</u>. <sup>6</sup> In all your ways <u>acknowledge him</u>, and he will make straight your paths. <sup>7</sup> Be not wise in your own eyes; <u>fear the LORD</u>, and <u>turn away from evil</u>. <sup>8</sup> <u>It will be healing to your flesh and refreshment to your bones.</u>

Micah 6:8 He has told you, O man, what is good; and what does the LORD require of you but to do justice, and to love kindness, and to walk humbly with your God
