No Fear when Jesus is near

Matthew 8:23-27 ²³ And when he got into the boat, his disciples followed him. ²⁴ And behold, there arose a great storm on the sea, so that the boat was being swamped by the waves; but he was asleep. ²⁵ And they went and woke him, saying, "Save us, Lord; we are perishing." ²⁶ And he said to them, "Why are you afraid, O you of little faith?" Then he rose and rebuked the winds and the sea, and there was a great calm. ²⁷ And the men marveled, saying, "What sort of man is this, that even winds and sea obey him?"

Then Jesus made the disciple go without Him

Matthew 14:22-26: ²² And after he had dismissed the crowds, he went up on the mountain by himself to pray. When evening came, he was there alone, ²⁴ but the boat by this time was a long way from the land, beaten by the waves, for the wind was against them. ²⁵ And in the fourth watch of the night he came to them, walking on the sea. ²⁶ But when the disciples saw him walking on the sea, they were terrified, and said, "It is a ghost!" and they cried out in fear. Jesus is the Way

Jesus coming from the impossible

Matthew 14:27-33 ²⁷ But immediately Jesus spoke to them, saying, "Take heart; it is I. Do not be afraid." ²⁸ And Peter answered him, "Lord, if it is you, command me to come to you on the water." ²⁹ He said, "Come." So Peter got out of the boat and walked on the water and came to Jesus. ³⁰ But when he saw the wind, he was afraid, and beginning to sink he cried out, "Lord, save me." ³¹ Jesus immediately reached out his hand and took hold of him, saying to him, "O you of little faith, why did you doubt?" ³² And when they got into the boat, the wind ceased. ³³ And those in the boat worshiped him, saying, "Truly you are the Son of God."

Faith must be confessed

Romans 10:9 If you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved..

Faith must act

James 2:17-18 So also faith by itself, if it does not have works, is dead. ¹⁸ But someone will say, "You have faith and I have works." Show me your faith apart from your works, and <u>I will show you my faith by my works</u>.

Faith must be tested

Luke 22:31-32 ³¹ "Simon, Simon, behold, <u>Satan demanded to have you</u>, that he might sift you like wheat, 32 but <u>I have prayed for you that your faith may not fail</u>. And <u>when you have turned again</u>, <u>strengthen your brothers."</u>

1 Peter 1:6-7 ⁶ In this you rejoice, though now for a little while, if necessary, you have been grieved by <u>various trials</u>, ⁷ so that <u>the tested genuineness of your faith—more precious than gold</u> that perishes though it is tested by fire—<u>may be found</u> to result in praise and glory and honor at the revelation of Jesus Christ.

It all happened at the cross

1 Peter 2:24 ²⁴ He himself bore our sins in his body on the tree, that we might die to sin and live to righteousness. By his wounds you have been healed.

Jesus restored Peter

1 Peter 5:10 And after you have <u>suffered</u> a little while, the God of <u>all grace</u>, who has called you to his eternal glory in Christ, will <u>himself restore</u>, <u>confirm</u>, <u>strengthen</u>, and <u>establish</u> you.

Faith comes through relationship

Romans 10:17 So faith comes from hearing, and hearing through the word of Christ

How will we overcome this world

1 John 5:4 For everyone who has been born of God <u>overcomes</u> the world. And <u>this is the victory</u> that has overcome the world - <u>our faith</u>.

Have I've been with Jesus?

Acts 4:13 Now when they saw the boldness of Peter and John, and perceived that they were uneducated, common men, they were astonished. And they recognized that they had been with Jesus.
