Galatians 6:1-10 (ESV) ¹ Brothers, if anyone is caught in any transgression, you who are spiritual should restore him in a spirit of gentleness. Keep watch on yourself, lest you too be tempted.

James 5:19-20 (ESV) My brothers, if anyone among you wanders from the truth and someone brings him back, let him know that whoever brings back a sinner from his wandering will save his soul from death and will cover a multitude of sins. We who are strong have an obligation to bear with the failings of the weak, and not to please ourselves.

Romans 15:1-2 (ESV) Let each of us please his neighbour for his good, to build him up.

Galatians 6:2 (ESV) Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ.

1 Thessalonians 5:14 (ESV) And we urge you, brothers, admonish the idle, encourage the fainthearted, help the weak, be patient with them all.

Galatians 5:14 (ESV) “For the whole law is fulfilled in one word: “You shall love your neighbor as yourself.”

1 John 4:21 (ESV) And this commandment we have from him: whoever loves God must also love his brother. .

Galatians 6:3 (ESV) For if anyone thinks he is something, when he is nothing, he deceives himself.

1 Corinthians 3:7 (ESV) So neither he who plants nor he who waters is anything, but only God who gives the growth.

Galatians 6:4 (ESV) But let each one test his own work, and then his reason to boast will be in himself alone and not in his neighbor.

2 Corinthians 13:5 (ESV) ⁵ Examine yourselves, to see whether you are in the faith. Test yourselves. Or do you not realize this about yourselves, that Jesus Christ is in you?—unless indeed you fail to meet the test!

Galatians 6:5 (ESV) For each will have to bear his own load.

Romans 14:12 (ESV) So then each of us will give an account of himself to God.

Galatians 6:6 (ESV) Let the one who is taught the word share all good things with the one who teaches.

Romans 15:27 (ESV) For they were pleased to do it, and indeed they owe it to them. For if the Gentiles have come to share in their spiritual blessings, they ought also to be of service to them in material blessings.

Galatians 6:7-8 “Do not be deceived: God is not mocked, for whatever one sows, that will he also reap. For the one who sows to his own flesh will from the flesh reap corruption, but the one who sows to the Spirit will from the Spirit reap eternal life.

Job 4:8 (ESV) As I have seen, those who plow iniquity and sow trouble reap the same.

Romans 6:21 (ESV) But what fruit were you getting at that time from the things of which you are now ashamed? For the end of those things is death.

Galatians 6:9 (ESV) And let us not grow weary of doing good, for in due season we will reap, if we do not give up

Matthew 10:22 (ESV) and you will be hated by all for my name's sake. But the one who endures to the end will be saved.

Galatians 6:10 (ESV) So then, as we have opportunity, let us do good to everyone, and especially to those who are of the household of faith.
