<sup>4</sup> They are all adulterers, burning like an oven whose fire the baker need not stir from the kneading of the dough till it rises. <sup>5</sup> On the day of the festival of our king the princes become inflamed with wine, and he joins hands with the mockers. <sup>6</sup> Their hearts are like an oven; they approach him with intrigue.
