## True sonship

### Romans 8:13-15

<sup>13</sup> For if you live according to the flesh you will die; but if by the Spirit you put to death the deeds of the body, you will live. <sup>14</sup> For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God. <sup>15</sup> For you did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but you received the Spirit of adoption by whom we cry out, "Abba, Father".

## Mature sons

### Hebrews 5:12-14

<sup>12</sup> For though by this time you ought to be teachers, you need someone to teach you again the first principles of the oracle of God; and you have come to need milk and not solid food. <sup>13</sup> For everyone who partakes *only* of milk *is* unskilled in the word of righteousness, for he is a babe. <sup>14</sup> But solid food belongs to those who are of full age, that is, those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.

## Mature sons & babes

Flesh (feelings) vs. Spirit

### Romans 8:8

<sup>8</sup> So then, those who are in the flesh cannot please God.

### Galatians 5:17

<sup>17</sup> For the flesh lusts against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh; and these are contrary to one another, so that you do not do the things that you wish.

## a: Continual obedience

### Romans 6:13-16

<sup>14</sup> For sin shall not have dominion over you, for you are not under law but grace

<sup>16</sup> Do you not know that to whom you present yourselves slaves to obey, you are the one's slave whom you obey.

## b: Continual infilling

### Ephesians 5:18-20

<sup>18</sup> And do not be drunk with wine in which is dissipation; but be filled with the Spirit, <sup>19</sup> speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord, <sup>20</sup> giving thanks always for all things to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ

## c: Continual exercise

### II Timothy 1:6-7

<sup>6</sup> Therefore I remind you to stir up the gift of God which is in you through the laying on of my hands.

<sup>7</sup> For God has not given us a Spirit of fear, but of power and of love and a sound mind.

**d: Continual worship**

**Colossians 3:16-17**

<sup>16</sup> Let the word of God dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord. <sup>17</sup> And whatever you do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him.

**e: Continual edification**

**I Corinthians 14:26**

<sup>26</sup> Whenever you come together, each of you has a psalm, has a teaching, has a tongue, has a revelation, has an interpretation. Let all things be done for edification.
