B THE FIVE ASPECTS OF BIBLICAL HOSPITALITY

1. INVITATION – to a CHRIST encounter

Getting the word out through information and follow-up

Luke 14: 16-17 (NLT) ¹⁶ Jesus replied with this story: "A man prepared a great feast and sent out many invitations. ¹⁷ When the banquet was ready, he sent his servant to tell the guests, 'Come, the banquet is ready.'

1. INVITATION – to a CHRIST encounter


✓ Creating anticipation – through focus on relevant needs

² There is more than enough room in my Father's home. If this were not so, would I have told you that I am going to prepare a place for you?

2. PREPARATION – (shaping) – the SPACE encounter John 14: 2-3 (NLT) ³ When everything is ready, I will come and get you, so that you will always be with me where I am

Romans 15:7 (AMP)


Welcome and receive [to your hearts] one another, then, even as Christ has welcomed and received you, for the glory of God.

"Look! I stand at the door and knock. If you hear my voice and open the door, I will come in, and we will share a meal together as friends."


✓ Developing sensitivity – unique individual & culture; personal space and pace




