John 5:18-20



2) The mystery of God

1Corinthians 2:7-12

But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, the hidden *wisdom* which God ordained before the ages for our glory, & which none of the rulers of this age knew; for had they known, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory.



1 Corinthians 2:7-12

9 But as it is written: "Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, nor have entered into the heart of man the things which God has prepared for those who loved Him." 10 But God has revealed *them* to us through His Spirit.



1 Corinthians 2:7-12

For the Spirit searches all things, yes, the deep things of God. 11 For what man knows the things of a man except the spirit of the man which is in him? Even so no one knows the things of God except the Spirit of God.



1 Corinthians 2:7-12

12 Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, that we might know the things that have been freely given to us by God.



3) Revelation knowledge

Ephesians 1:15-23

Therefore I also, after I heard of your faith in the Lord Jesus and your love for all the saints,¹⁶ do not cease to give thanks for you, making mention of you in my prayers: 17 that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ,

the Father of glory may give to you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him, 18 the eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that you may know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints,

19 and what is the exceeding greatness of His power toward us who believe, according to the working of His mighty power 20 which He worked in Christ when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly places,



Ephesians 1:15-23

21 far above all principality and power and might and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age but also in that which is to come. 22 And He put all things under His feet, and gave Him *to be* head over all *things* to the church,



Ephesians 1:15-23

23 which is His body, the fullness of Him who fills all in all.
