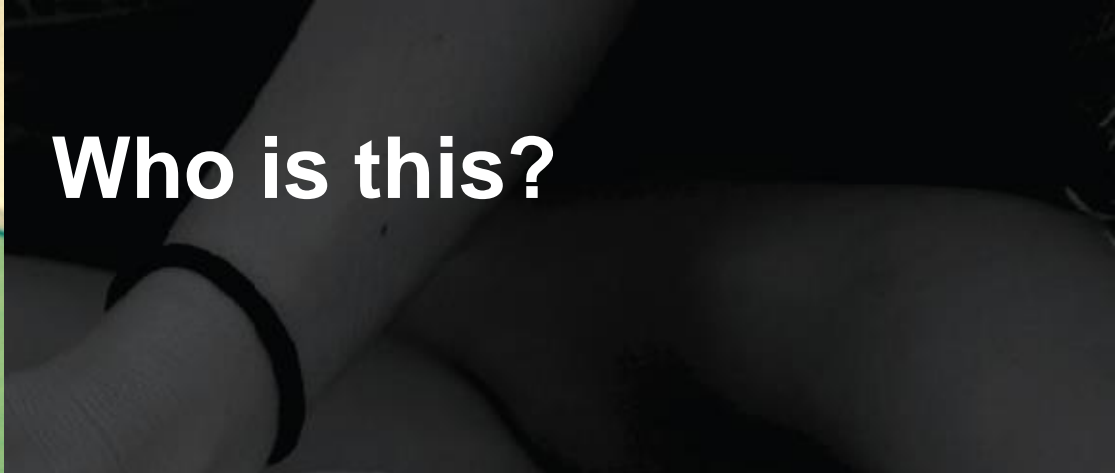

**Period: Return**

**Person: Ezra**

**Ezra 6:14-16**

And the elders of the Jews built and prospered through the prophesying of Haggai... And the people of Israel, the priests and the Levites, and the rest of the returned exiles, celebrated the dedication of this house of God with joy.





**Period: Messianic**

**Person: Jesus**

**John 1:14** And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth.

**Acts 15:16-17**

'After this I will return, and I will rebuild the tent of David that has fallen; I will rebuild its ruins, and I will restore it, that the remnant of mankind may seek the Lord, and all the Gentiles who are called by my name...'
