1Timothy 6:6 -14

Now godliness with contentment is great gain. For we brought nothing into this world, and it is certain we can carry nothing out. And having food and clothing, with these we shall be content. But those who desire to be rich fall into temptation and a snare, and *into* many foolish and harmful lusts which drown men in destruction and perdition...



10 For the <u>love</u> of money is a root of all kinds of evil, for which some have strayed from the faith in their greediness, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows. But you, O man of God, <u>flee</u> these things and <u>pursue</u> righteousness, godliness, faith, love, patience, gentleness.

Definitions


1) Godliness

The fear or reverence of God; to worship; reverence manifested in worship

2) Contentment

Satisfaction with what one has, sufficiency, to be filled with something or satisfied

- A surrender to holiness


Psalm 25:14


B) Hunger for God/satisfied in Him


Matthew 5:6






John 14:16-21

D) Desire for eternal life Colosians 2:6-10 As you therefore have received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him, rooted and built up in Him and established in the faith, as you have been taught, abounding in it with thanksgiving. Beware lest anyone cheat you through philosophy and empty deceit
