# Excludes: Chasing after Wind

## Eccl 1: 1-3

THE WORDS of the Preacher, the son of David and king in Jerusalem. 2 Vapor of vapors and futility of futilities, says the Preacher. Vapor of vapors and futility of futilities! All is vanity (emptiness, falsity, and vainglory). 3 What profit does man have left from all his toil at which he toils under the sun? [Is life worth living?]

# Excludes: This World

## Rom 12: 2

Do not be conformed to this world (this age), [fashioned after and adapted to its external, superficial customs], but be transformed (changed) by the [entire] renewal of your mind [by its new ideals and its new attitude], so that you may prove [for yourselves] what is the good and acceptable and perfect will of God, even the thing which is good and acceptable and perfect [in His sight for you].

# Excludes: This World

## Ps 1: 1

[ *The Way of the **Righteous** and the **End** of the Ungodly* ] Blessed is the man Who walks not in the counsel of the ungodly, Nor stands in the **path** of sinners, Nor sits in the seat of the scornful;

## 1 Cor 15: 33

Do not be misled: "**Bad company** corrupts good character."

# Includes: Strong Family

## 1 Tim 5: 8

If anyone fails to provide for his relatives, and especially for those of his **own family**, he has disowned the faith [by failing to accompany it with fruits] and is worse than an unbeliever [who performs his obligation in these matters].

## 1 Tim 3: 5

(If anyone does not know how to manage his **own family**, how can he take care of God's church?)



# Includes: Strong Family (Husband)

**Eph 5: 28**

In this same way, **husbands** ought to **love** their wives as their own bodies. He who **loves his wife** loves himself.

# Includes: Strong Family (Husband)

## Prov 4: 1

Hear, ye children, the instruction of a father, and attend to know understanding.

PRIEST – instructs, teaches, corrects

# Includes: Strong Family (Husband)

## Prov 19: 23

The fear of the Lord leads to life, And he who has it will abide in satisfaction; He will not be visited with evil.

PROPHET – takes leadership

Includes: Strong Family (Husband)

KING – Provides all needs, decrees

JUDGE – Protects, models integrity

# Includes: Strong Family (Wife)

## Eph 5: 24

Now as the church **submits** to Christ, so also wives should **submit** to their husbands in everything.

# Includes: Spiritual Family

**Gal 6: 2**

Carry each other's burdens, and in this way you will fulfill the law of Christ.

# Includes: Contentment

## Tim 6: 6, 8

6 But godliness with **contentment** is great gain.

8 But if we have food and clothing, we will be **content** with that.

# Includes: Contentment

Heb 13: 5

Keep your lives free from the love of money and be **content** with what you have, because God has said, "Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you."
