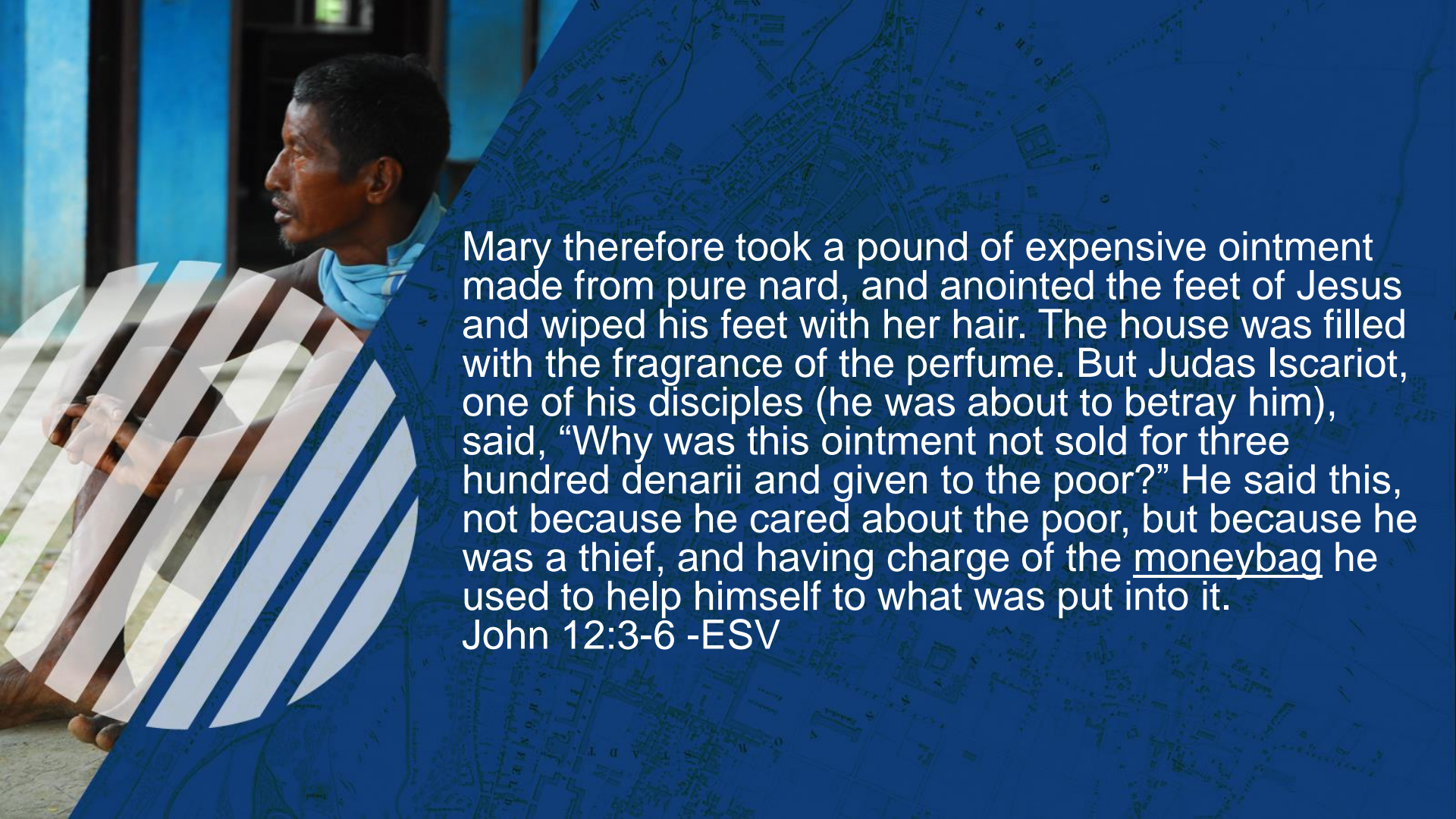

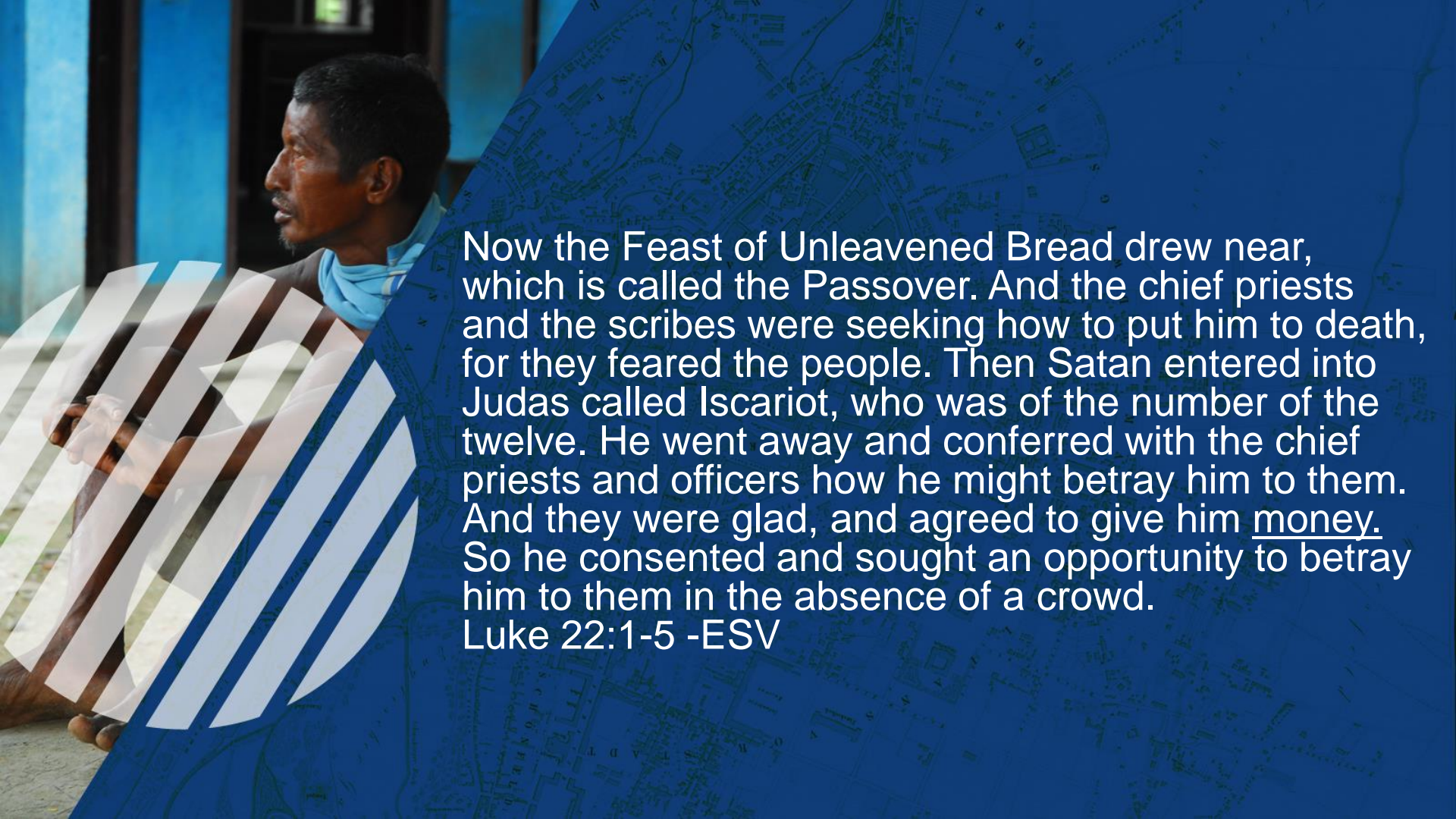
John 12:3-6 & Luke 22:1-5

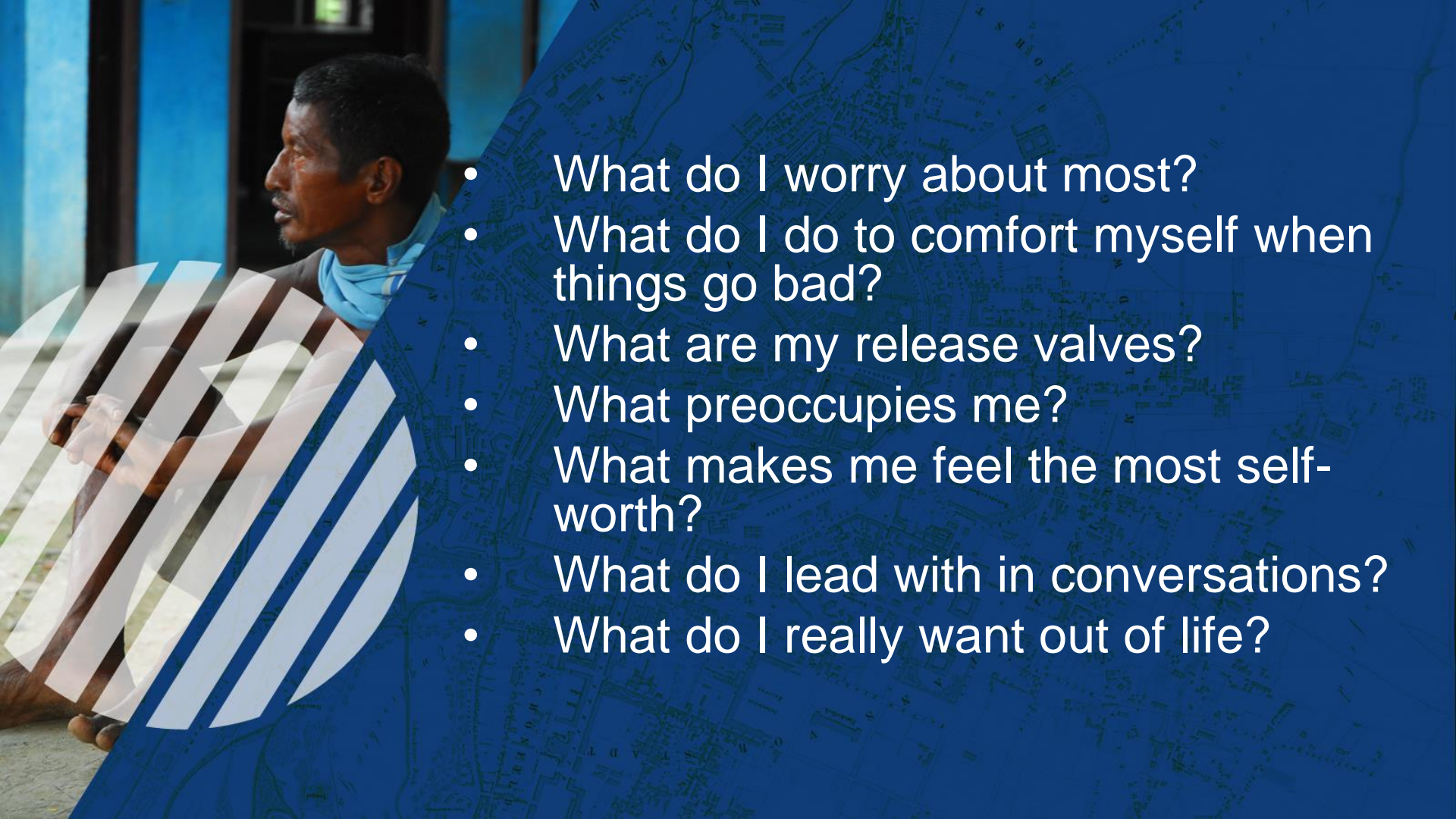

## Approval Idolatry

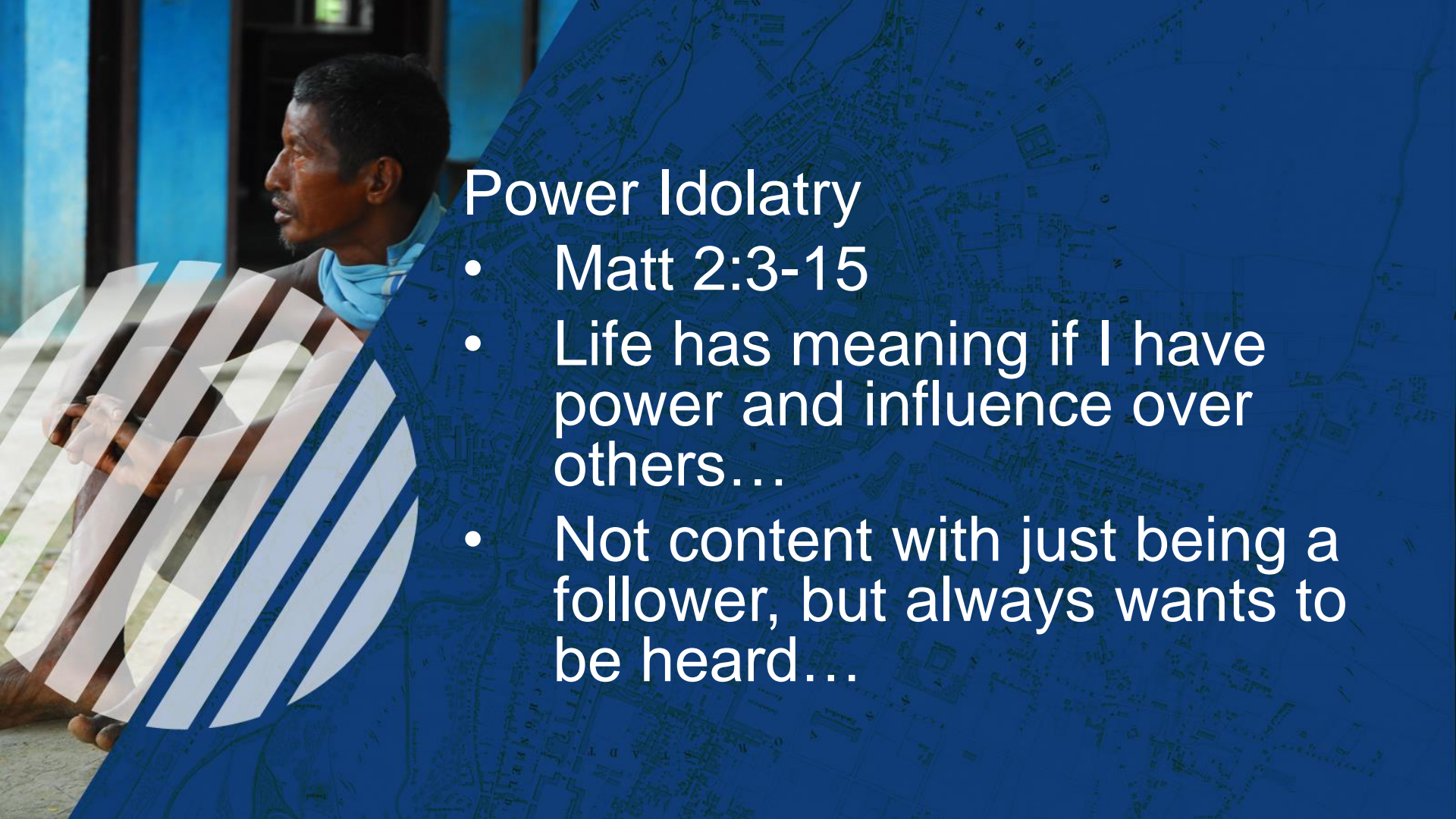
- Acts 24:25 & 27
