

Understand His Deity

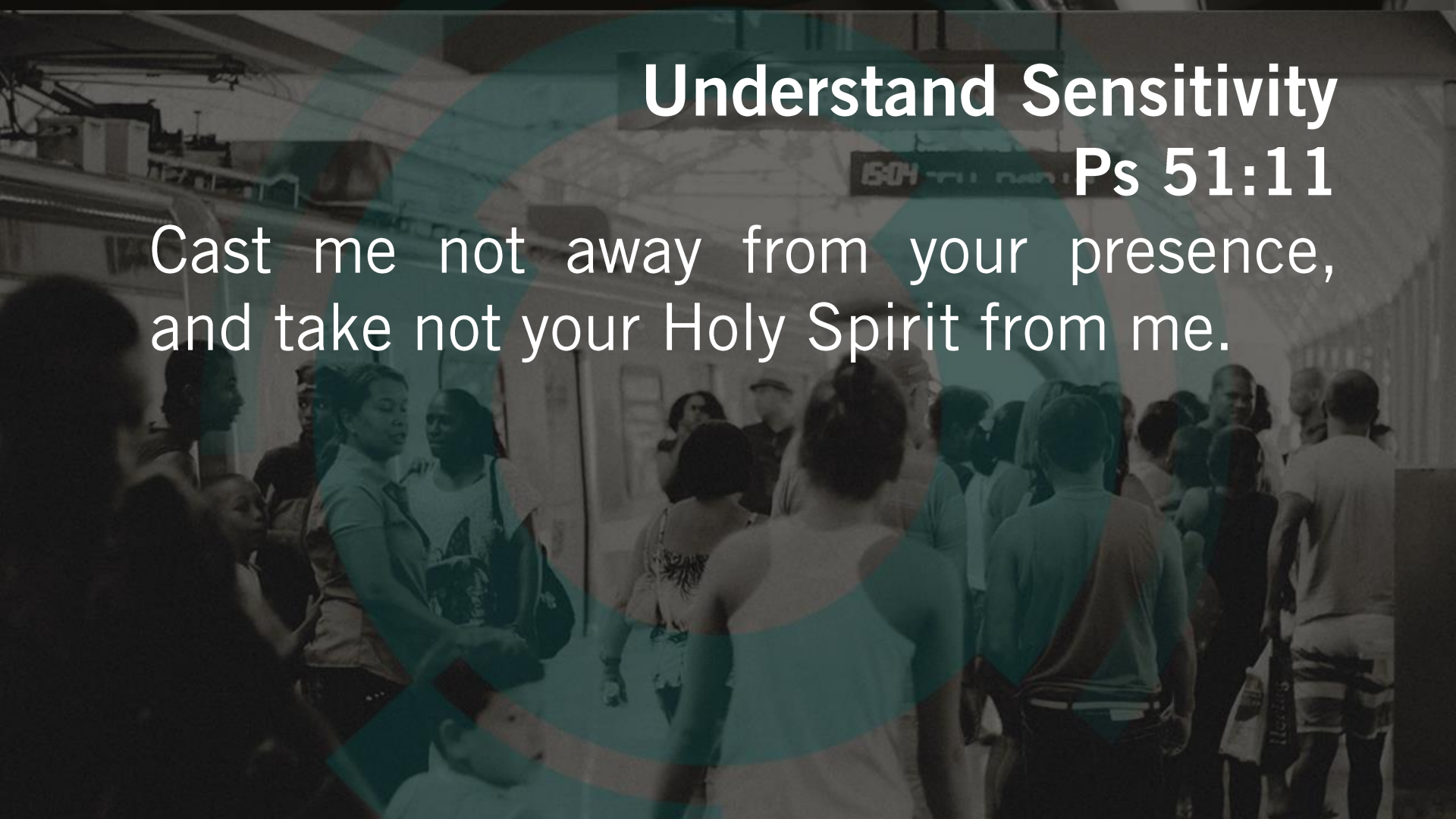
Acts 5

Understand Sensitivity (Do not grieve)

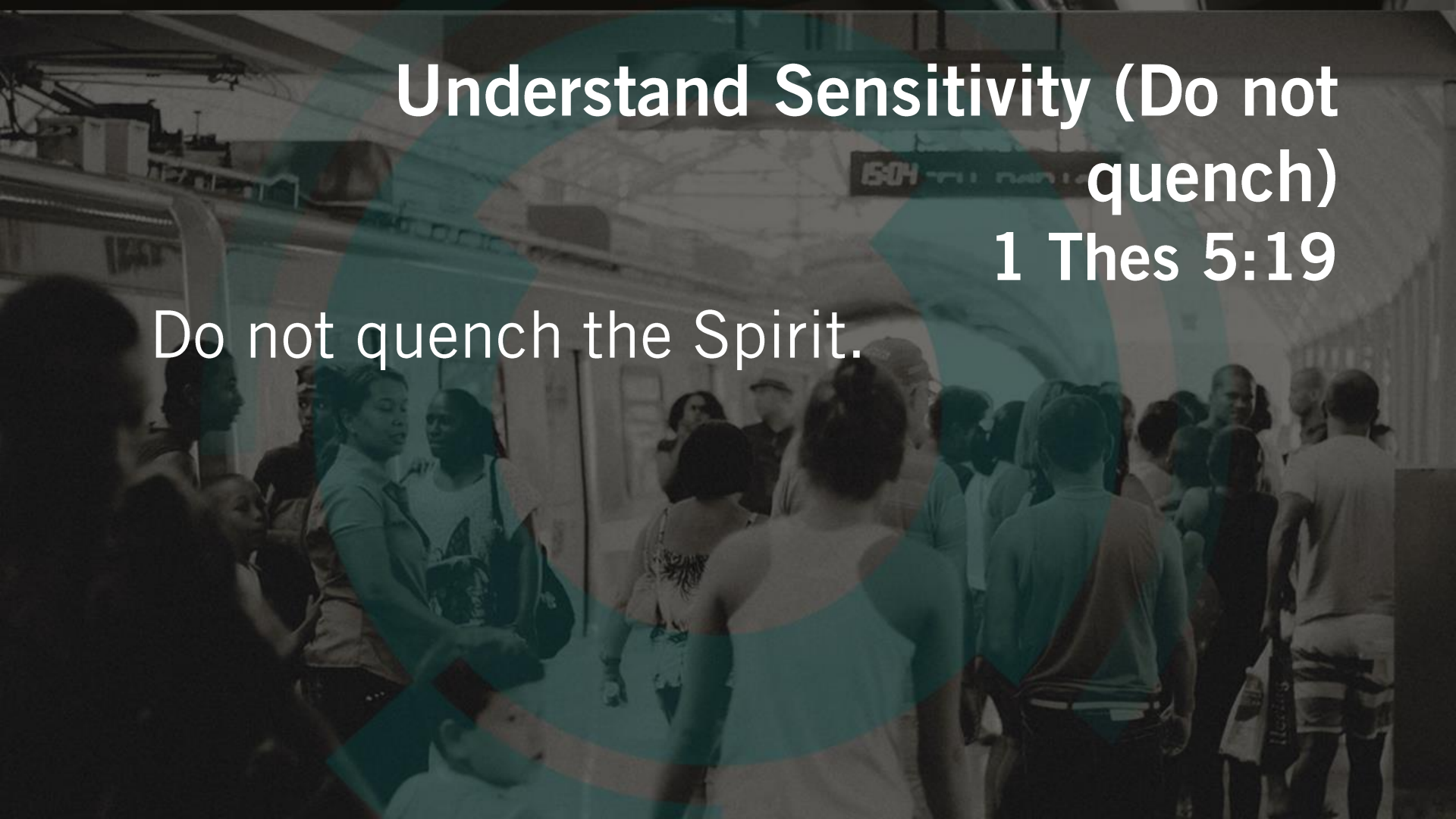
Eph 4:30-32

Understand Role (Conviction)

John 16:8-11

8 And when he comes, he will convict the world concerning sin and righteousness and judgment: 9 concerning sin, because they do not believe in me; 10 concerning righteousness, because I go to the Father, and you will see me no longer; 11 concerning judgment, because the ruler of this world is judged.

Understand Role (Anointing/ Power)

Acts 1:8

But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.”

Understand Purpose (Helper)

John 16:5-7

But now I am going to him who sent me, and none of you asks me, 'Where are you going?' 6 But because I have said these things to you, sorrow has filled your heart. 7 Nevertheless, I tell you the truth: it is to your advantage that I go away, for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you. But if I go, I will send him to you.

Understand Purpose (Edify)

1 Cor 14:12, 26

12 So with yourselves, since you are eager for manifestations of the Spirit, strive to excel in building up the church.

26 What then, brothers? When you come together, each one has a hymn, a lesson, a revelation, a tongue, or an interpretation. Let all things be done for building up.

Ministry of Holy Spirit
