

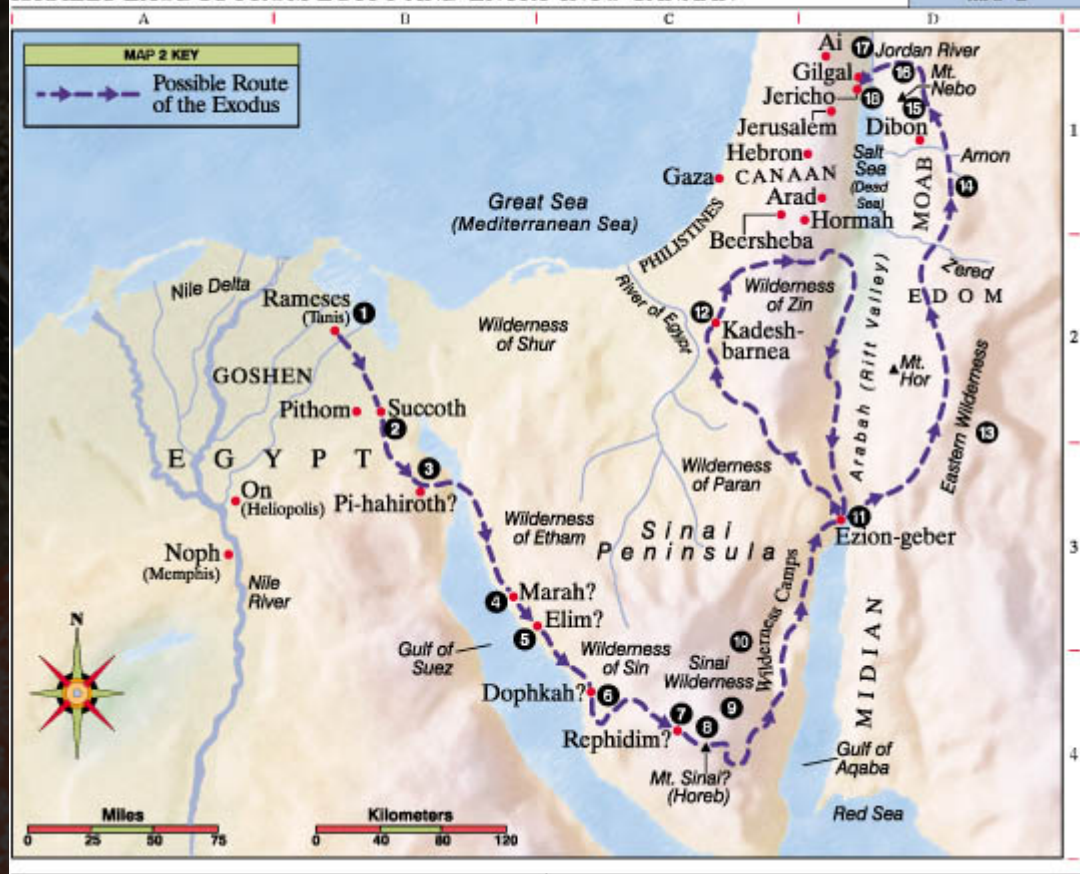

- God's people moved with His presence, Ex 13:21, Neh 9:19
- Ex 24: 12-18 Moses called into the presence of God
- Meticulous details of the tabernacle
- Purpose in Ex 25: 8 Let them construct a sanctuary for Me, that I may dwell among them.



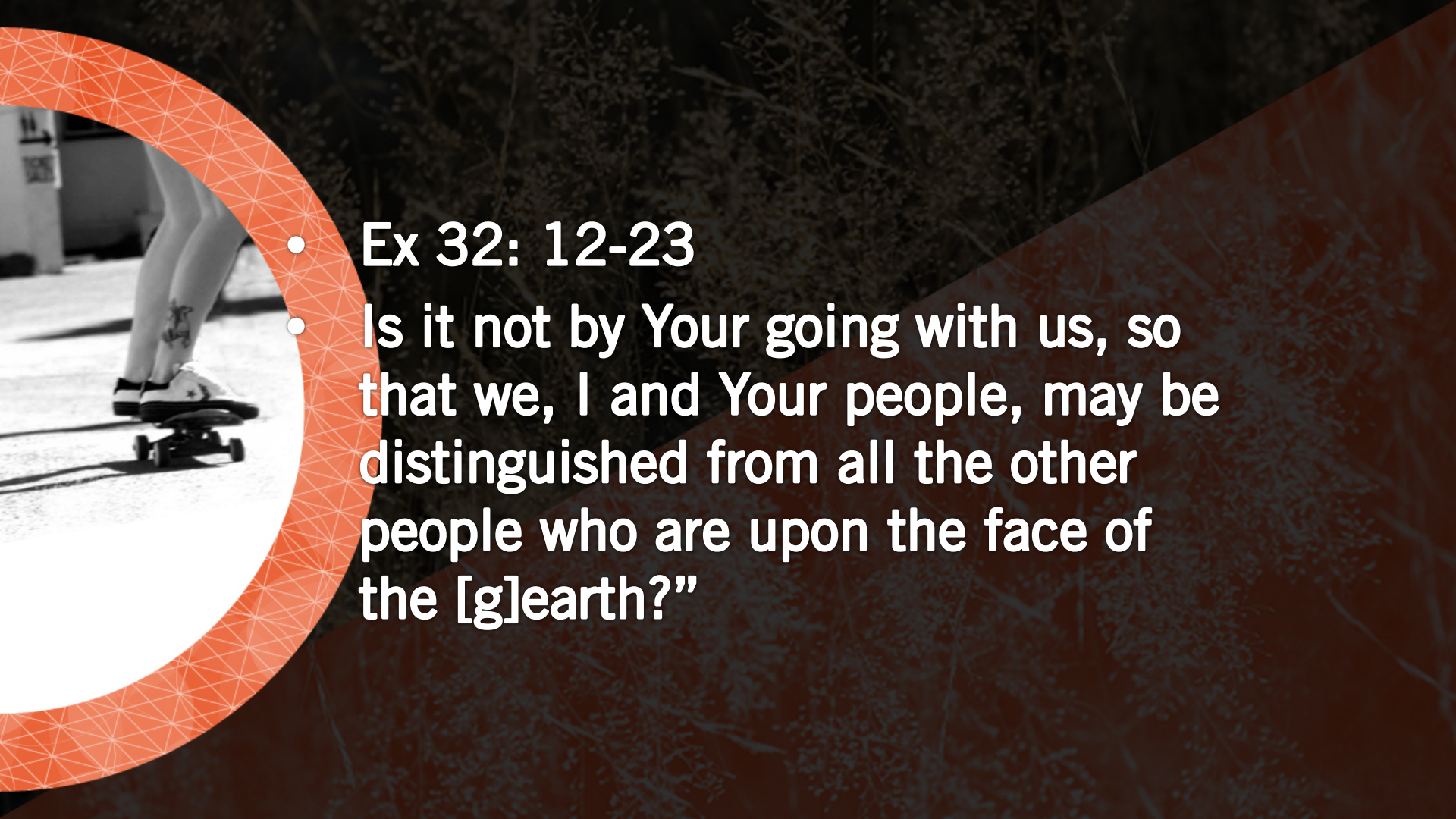
- People grew weary
- Ex 32: 1 Now when the people saw that Moses delayed to come down from the mountain, the people assembled about Aaron and said to him, “Come, make us a god who will go before us; as for this Moses, the man who brought us up from the land of Egypt, we do not know what has become of him.”



- Ex 32: 11-14
- Moses entreats
- Ex 33: Go up to a land flowing with milk and honey; for I will not go up in your midst, because you are an obstinate people, and I might destroy you on the way.”



- Ex 32: 12-23
- 15 Then he said to Him, “If Your presence does not go with us, do not lead us up from here. 16 For how then can it be known that I have found favor in Your sight, I and Your people?”



- Ex 32: 12-23
- Is it not by Your going with us, so that we, I and Your people, may be distinguished from all the other people who are upon the face of the [g]earth?”
