HOLIDAY BY THE C:

1. REST

Gen 2:2 And on the seventh day God ended his work which he had made; and he rested on the seventh day from all his work which he had made.

Mark 2:27 And he said unto them, The sabbath was made for man, and not man for the sabbath: 28 Therefore the Son of man is Lord also of the sabbath.



HOLIDAY BY THE C:

2. DESTINATION

Hebrews 3:

¹⁶ For who heard and rebelled?
Wasn't it really all who came out of
Egypt under Moses? ¹⁷ And who was
He provoked with for 40 years? Was
it not with those who sinned, whose
bodies fell in the wilderness?



¹⁸ And who did He swear to that they would not enter His rest, if not those who disobeyed? ¹⁹ So we see that they were unable to enter because of unbelief.

3. PROVISION:

Isaiah 55 “Come, everyone who is thirsty, come to the waters; and you without money, come, buy, and eat! Come, buy wine and milk without money and without cost!


4. EATING AND DRINKING:
