The Christian life belongs to the spiritual realm

How did Jesus live the Christian life?

- I can of Myself do nothing. As I hear, I judge; and My judgment is righteous, because I do not seek My own will but the will of the Father who sent Me.(John 5:30)
- Then Jesus said to them, "When you lift up the Son of Man, then you will know that I am *He*, and *that* I do nothing of Myself; but as My Father taught Me, I speak these things. ²⁹ And He who sent Me is with Me. The Father has not left Me alone, for I always do those things that please Him." (John 8:28-9)

We can not live the Christian life

.....for without Me you can do nothing.(John15:5)

Christ lives the Christian life in us

I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit. (John 15:5)

I can do *all things* through Christ^[b] who strengthens me. (Philippians 4:13)
