
### 2. HEARTCore:



### 2.1 What is the HEART?

- ✓ Kardia kar-dee'-ah: Prolonged from a primary κάρ kar (Latin cor, heart); the heart, that is, (figuratively) the thoughts or feelings (mind); also (by analogy) the middle: (+ broken-) heart (-ed).
- ✓ The Bible mentions the human heart almost 300 times. In essence, this is what it says: the heart is that spiritual part of us where our emotions and desires dwell.






✓ **Greeks and Romans**: struggle was between the mind and the passions

✓ Modern day: believe our deepest feelings are "who we really are" [Battle: emotions and a repressive society]

✓ The Bible: Struggle / battle happens within a single entity — the human heart



The **heart** is used as a metaphor for the seat of our most basic orientation, our deepest commitments — what we trust the most (Proverbs 3:5; 23:26); it is what we most love and hope in, what we most treasure, what captures our imagination.



# 2.2 Blessed:

✓ Makarios I mak-ar'-ee-os I A prolonged form of the poetical μάκαρ makar (meaning the same); supremely blest; by extension fortunate, well off: - blessed, happy (X -ier).

# ✓ Luke 11:27-28 (HCSB) True Blessedness

As He was saying these things, a woman from the crowd raised her voice and said to Him, "The womb that bore You and the one who nursed You are blessed!" 28 He said, "Even more, those who hear the word of God and keep it are blessed!"

### **2.3** Pure:

✓ Greek: **katharos** [kath-ar-os'] Of uncertain affinity; clean (literally or figuratively): - **clean, clear, pure**.

✓ The PURE heart can only be a saved heart, sanctified one


### 3. PURE HEART WILL SEE:
