



19 that is, in Christ God was reconciling[c] the world to himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and entrusting to us the message of reconciliation. 20





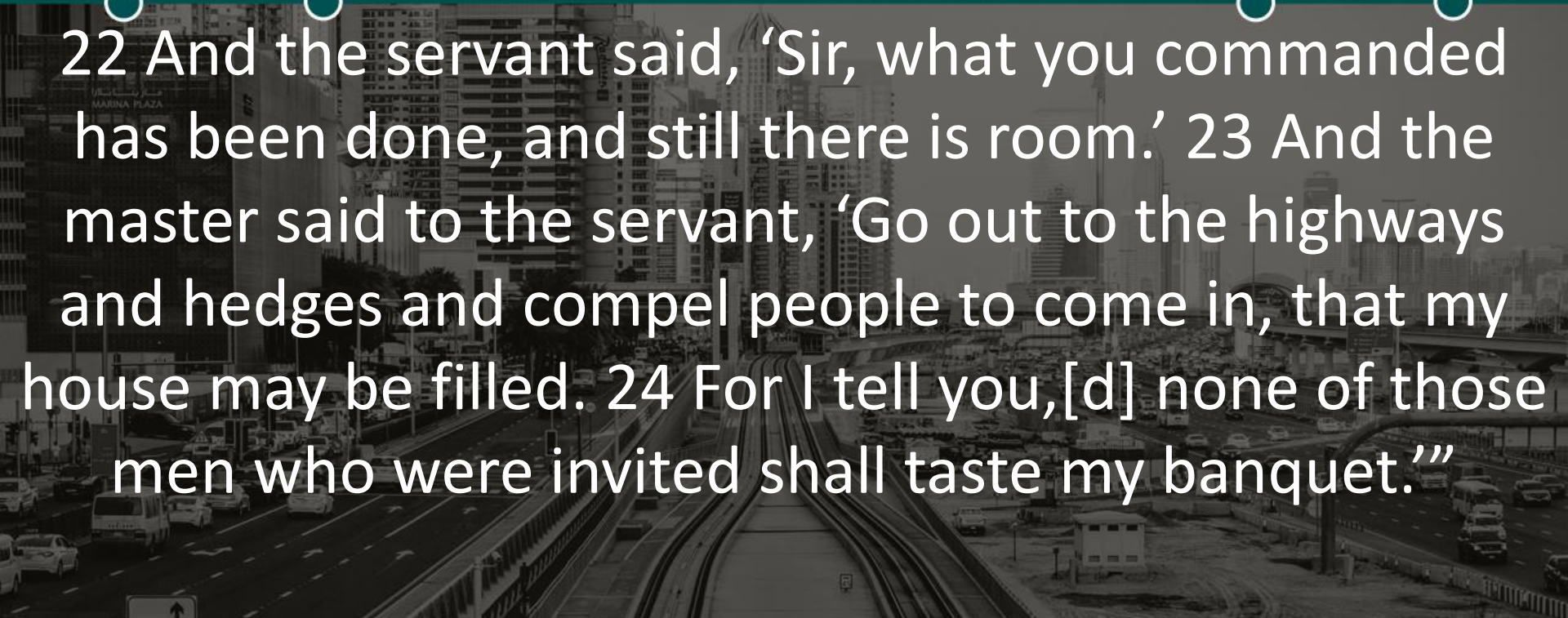
19 And another said, 'I have bought five yoke of oxen, and I go to examine them. Please have me excused.'
