#### **Definition:**

Hospitality | friendly and generous reception and entertainment of 'sharing Jesus with' guests, visitors, or strangers.

<u>friendliness</u>, hospitableness, <u>welcome</u>, <u>warm reception</u>, <u>helpfulness</u>, <u>neighbourliness</u>, warmth, <u>warm-heartedness</u>, <u>kindness</u>, kind-heartedness, congeniality, geniality, <u>sociability</u>, conviviality, cordiality, amicability, amenability, <u>generosity</u>, <u>liberality</u>, bountifulness, <u>open-handedness</u>.

GREEK I Philoxenos fond of guests, that is, hospitable: - given to (lover of, use) hospitality.

Philonexia hospitableness: - entertain strangers, hospitality.

## 1.1 People LONG to BELONG
