Matthew 5:3 "Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven."

- ✓ Fortunate, well off; blessed, happy
- ✓ Kingdom: where the King rule and reign
- ✓ Where the King's will be done
- Humble heart, when we are utterly dependent upon God, knowing we need Him for all

Trust and Faith



2.1 Examples:

Abraham and Sarah – Isaac; Joseph; Moses; David; Hannah; Israelite nation; Elizabeth and Zechariah; Jesus Christ and many more...

2.2 Definition: WAITING

Hebrew: qâvâh A primitive root; to bind together (perhaps by twisting), that is, collect; (figuratively) to expect: - gather (together), look, patiently, tarry, wait (for, on, upon)*

Greek: apekdechomai to expect fully: - look (wait) for.

Waiting on God is active trust and hopeful expectation in His timing, plan, and promises, accompanied by patience, prayer and faith.





3.2 In every waiting: In every season –

a. He strengthens me:

Isaiah 40:31 "But they who wait for the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings like eagles; they shall run and not be weary; they shall walk and not faint."

Active wait on Him and a seeking of Him alone

b. Grow in an Active Dependence and Trust:

Psalm 37:7 "Be still before the Lord and wait patiently for him; do not fret when people succeed in their ways, when they carry out their wicked schemes."

- not passive but an active reliance on God
- involves prayer, seeking God's guidance, and staying attentive to His direction | INTIMACY
- also involves preparing one's heart, mind, and actions while trusting God to bring the desired outcome.


Weaving in the Waiting

c. Know Him, His ways and plans:

Psalm 130:5 "I wait for the Lord, my soul waits, and in his word I hope"

Romans 8:28 And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to His purpose.
