



partnership in gospel intentional partnering



philippians 1:3-5

philippians 1:27-28, 2:1-2


Only let your manner of life be worthy of the gospel of Christ, so that whether I come and see you or am absent, I may hear of you that you are standing firm in one spirit, with one mind striving side by side for the faith of the gospel, and not frightened in anything by your opponents...

participation in spirit unity for power



philippians 1:27-28, 2:1-3

So if there is... any <u>participation in the Spirit</u>, any affection and sympathy, complete my joy by being of the same mind, having the same love, being in full accord and of one mind. Do nothing from rivalry or conceit, but in humility count others more significant than yourselves.



partaking in suffering enduring together



philippians 3:8-10

For his sake I have suffered the loss of all things and count them as rubbish, in order that I may gain Christ... that I may know him and the power of his resurrection, and may share his sufferings, becoming like him in his death, that by any means possible I may attain the resurrection from the dead. refer: phil 1:29-30 "also suffer for His sake"

partnering in work labouring together



philippians 4:3

Yes, I ask you also, true companion, help these women, who have labored side by side with me in the gospel together with Clement and the rest of my <u>fellow workers</u>, whose names are in the book of life.

partner through giving carrying the burden



philippians 4:15

And you Philippians yourselves know that in the beginning of the gospel, when I left Macedonia, no church entered into partnership with me in giving and receiving, except you.
