



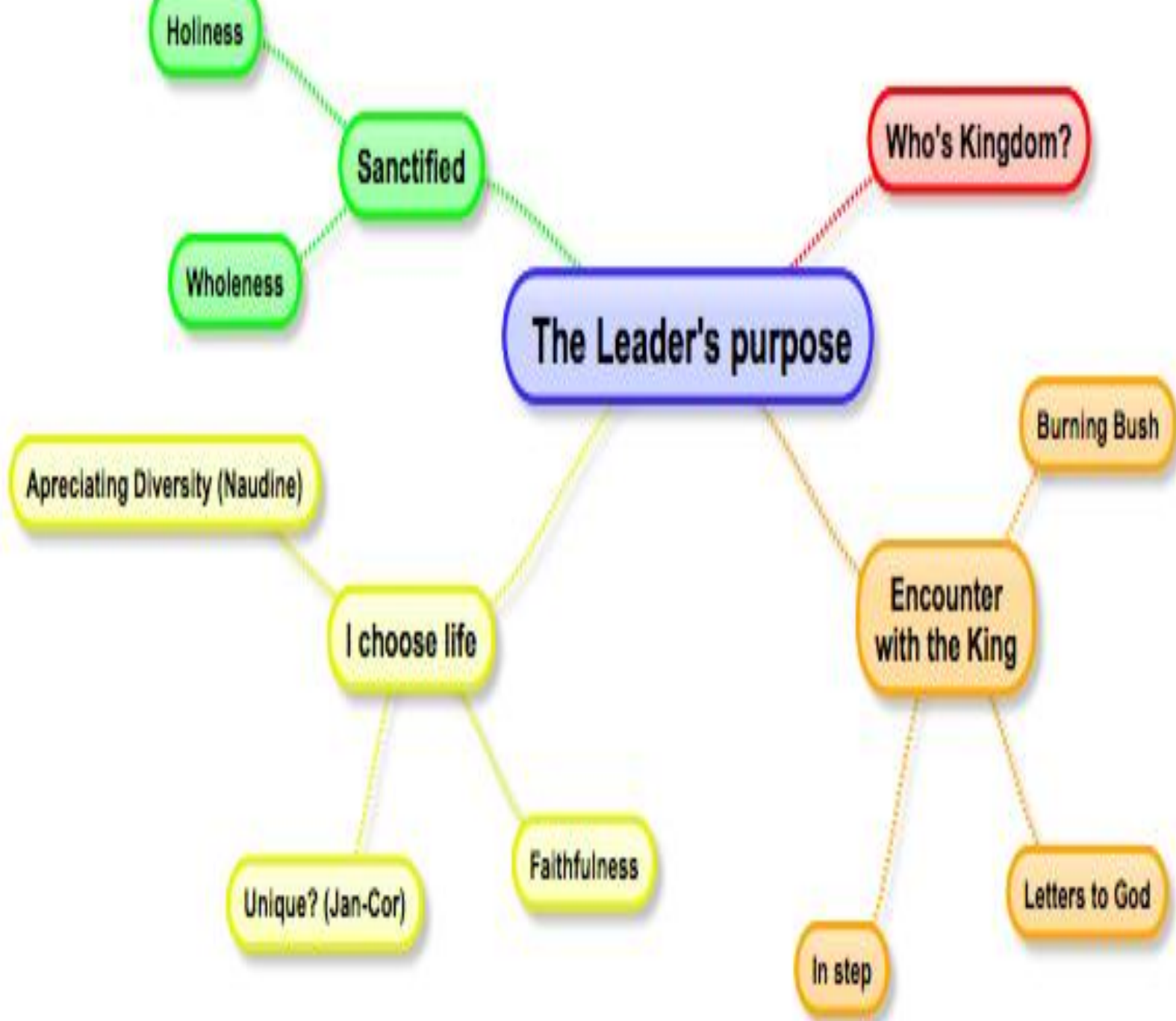

1. Holiness

1.2 Fearing Idols

Matthew 19:16-22

16And behold, a man came up to him, saying, “Teacher, what good deed must I do to have eternal life?” 17And he said to him, “Why do you ask me about what is good? There is only one who is good. If you would enter life, keep the commandments.” 18He said to him, “Which ones?” And Jesus said, “You shall not murder, You shall not commit adultery, You shall not steal, You shall not bear false witness, 19Honor your father and mother, and, You shall love your neighbor as yourself.”



20The young man said to him, “All these I have kept. What do I still lack?” 21Jesus said to him, “If you would be perfect, go, sell what you possess and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; and come, follow me.” 22When the young man heard this he went away sorrowful, for he had great possessions.

1.2 Fearing Idols

- Are you afraid of what God would expect of you to do in following His kingdom?
- Moving to another place?
- Selling your possessions?



2. Wholeness

2.1 Broken reed

This selfishness and control manifests through (pendulum):

Self pity through fear and rejection (focus on own ability) - shame, guilt

- Self pity leads to passivity because of being rejected.
- Always defending and justifying
- Suicide



2. Wholeness

2.1 Broken reed

Rebellion leads to rejecting those who reject you.

- Rebellion (arrogance that focus on own ability)
 - pride
- Rebellion against authority opens the door to the devil to mislead us.
- Homicide - wants to get rid of people that bring hurt.

Or total surrender to God's ability in you through **humility and contentment.**



2. Wholeness

2.1 Broken reed

There is an established value system that kicks in when the flesh is being tested.

- Both root of self
- Both leads to isolation, loneliness, bitterness, frustration



2. Wholeness

2.2 Broken reed

The flesh usually get tested by the level of preoccupation with control and two common magnifiers expose us:

- Money/assets
- Relationships (manipulation)

2.2 Broken reed

- “Humility is a willingness to be known for who you are.” (Thomson, 1986)
- Humility allows one to take an honest look at your shortfall against the Truth of God.

2.2 Broken reed

- -Through the cursing of our identity Satan hopes to (Hill, 1992):
 - Distort or replace entirely your image of who God has called you to be.
 - Drive you out of your place of habitation, the place of protection which is yours.(Your family, marriage,church,employment, home,city, country.)

2.2 Broken reed

- Steal your inheritance - that which God has meant to be an inheritance or heritage to you. (Your children, finances, ministry, relationships.)
