## 1 Corinthians 12: 4 – 11 (NKJV)



# 1 Corinthians 14:1 – 5 (NKJV)

<sup>1</sup> Pursue love, and desire spiritual gifts, but especially that you may prophesy. <sup>2</sup> For he who speaks in a tongue does not speak to men but to God, for no one understands him; however, in the spirit he speaks mysteries. <sup>3</sup> But he who prophesies speaks edification and exhortation and comfort to men.



## 1 Corinthians 14:1 – 5 (NKJV)

<sup>4</sup> He who speaks in a tongue edifies himself, but he who prophesies edifies the church. <sup>5</sup> I wish you all spoke with tongues, but even more that you prophesied; for he who prophesies is greater than he who speaks with tongues, unless indeed he interprets, that the church may receive edification.






Revelation 20:10 (NKJV)

Your young men shall see visions.

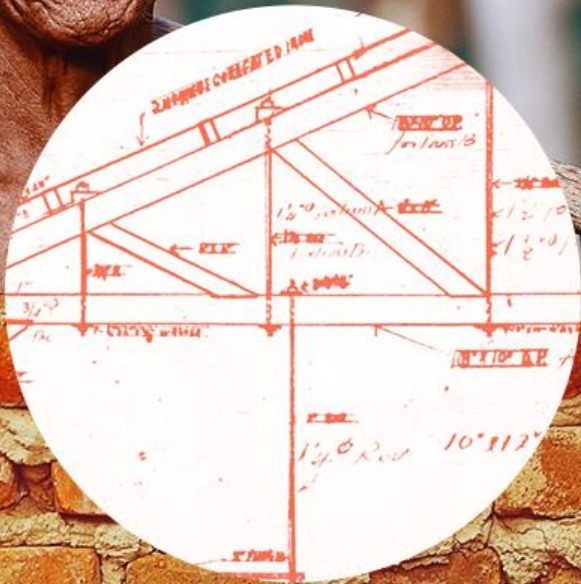
