


Matthew 3:2 & 8 (AMP)

² "Repent [change your inner self—your old way of thinking, regret past sins, live your life in a way that proves repentance; seek God's purpose for your life], for the kingdom of heaven is at hand."

⁸ So produce fruit that is consistent with <u>repentance</u> [demonstrating new behavior that proves a change of heart, and a conscious decision to turn away from sin];




Acts 26: 19 & 20 (AMP)

19 "So, King Agrippa, I was not disobedient to the heavenly vision, 20 but I openly proclaimed first to those at Damascus, then at Jerusalem and throughout the region of Judea, and even to the Gentiles, that they should repent [change their inner self-their old way of thinking] and turn to God, doing deeds and living lives which are consistent with repentance.

Acts 2:38 (AMP)

38 And Peter said to them, "Repent [change your old way of thinking, turn from your sinful ways, accept and follow Jesus as the Messiah] and be baptized, each of you, in the name of Jesus Christ because of the forgiveness of your sins; and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.



Matthew 3:8 (AMP) ⁸ So produce fruit that is consistent with repentance [demonstrating new behavior that proves a change of heart, and a conscious decision to turn away from sin];

Restoring the relationship with God in our spirit is called Salvation.


Restoring the relationship with God in our soul


(will, mind & emotions) is called Deliverance. Restoring the relationship with God in our body is called Healing.

SINNERS PRAYER: You go to the Lord in prayer:

- Lord, I acknowledge my sin.
- I acknowledge that I'm guilty before you Lord and that I need to be saved.
- I declare that Jesus paid for my sin on the cross. He carried my sin on the cross.
- I ask God to forgive my sin and to clean me from it.
- I thank God for making me new and for receiving me as His child.
- I turn away from sinful ways and turn to God from now on.







1 Corinthians 12 : 8-10 (AMP)

⁸ To one is given through the [Holy] Spirit [the power to speak] the message of wisdom, and to another [the power to express] the word of knowledge and understanding according to the same Spirit; 9 to another [wonder-working] faith [is given] by the same [Holy] Spirit, and to another the [extraordinary] gifts of healings by the one Spirit; 10 and to another the working of miracles, and to another prophecy [foretelling the future, speaking a new message from God to the people], and to another discernment of spirits [the ability to distinguish sound, godly doctrine from the deceptive doctrine of man-made religions and cults], to another various kinds of [unknown] tongues, and to another interpretation of tongues.

Wisdom: future; disclosing the mind, purpose and way of God as applied to a specific situation.

Knowledge: current or past experiences.

Faith: ability to believe God without a doubt: only imparted when a situation arises.

Healings: deliver the sick and to destroy the works of the devil in human bodies.

Miracles: something that could not be done naturally.

Prophecy: forth telling of the will of God: edifying, up-building and exhortation

<u>Discerning of Spirits</u>: to detect the realm of the spirits and their activities.

<u>Tongues</u>: speak in a language he does not know/ understand. Interpretation of tongues: reveal the meaning of the tongues.
