### We are living stones

Coming to Him as to a living stone, rejected indeed by men, but chosen by God and precious, you also, as living stones, are being built up a spiritual house, a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ. 1 Peter 2:45 NKJV

"Our fathers had the tent of witness in the wilderness, just as he who spoke to Moses directed him to make it, according to the pattern that he had seen. So it was until the days of David, who found favor in the sight of God and asked to find a dwelling place for the God of Jacob. Acts 7:44-46 ESV

Yet the Most High does not dwell in houses made by hands, as the prophet says, "Heaven is my throne, and the earth is my footstool. What kind of house will you build for me, says the Lord, or what is the place of my rest? Did not my hand make all these things?' Acts 7:47-50 ESV

#### It starts with the heart

For thus says the High and Lofty One, Who inhabits eternity, whose name is Holy: "I dwell in the high and holy place, with him who has a contrite and humble spirit, to revive the spirit of the humble, and to revive the heart of the contrite ones. Isaiah 57:15

Why are you so far from saving me, from the words of my groaning? 2.0 my God, I cry by day, but you do not answer, and by night, but I find no rest. 3. Yet you are holy, enthroned on the praises of Israel. Psalms 22:1-3 ESV

I will make myself yet more contemptible than this, and I will be abased in your eyes. But by the female servants of whom you have spoken, by them I shall be held in honor." 2 Samuel 6:21-22 ESV

As the ark of the Lord came into the city of David, Michal the daughter of Saul looked out of the window and saw King David leaping and dancing before the Lord , and she despised him in her heart. 2 Samuel 6:16 ESV A worshipping house invites the reign of God Where God is praised, He reigns. Where God reigns, His healing river flows. Is His river flowing in your heart and through your mouth and body?

Do you desire this river to flow to the nations?

And making a whip of cords, he drove them all out of the temple, with the sheep and oxen. And he poured out the coins of the money-changers and overturned their tables. And he told those who sold the pigeons, "Take these things away; do not make my Father's house a house of trade." His disciples remembered that it was written, "Zeal for your house will consume me." John 2:14-17 ESV

And he said to them, "The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few. Therefore pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest. Luke 10:1-2

And David the king said to all the assembly, "Solomon my son, whom alone God has chosen, is young and inexperienced, and the work is great, for the palace will not be for man but for the Lord God. 1 Chronicles 29:1 ESV

3So I have provided for the house of my God, so far as I was able, the gold for the things of gold, the silver for the things of silver, and the bronze for the things of bronze, the iron for the things of iron, and wood for the things of wood, besides great quantities of onyx and stones for setting, antimony, colored stones, all sorts of precious stones and marble. 1 Chronicles 29:2 ESV

Moreover, in addition to all that <u>I</u> have provided for the holy house, <u>I</u> have a treasure of <u>my own</u> of gold and silver, and because of <u>my</u> devotion to the house of <u>my</u> God <u>I</u> give it to the house of <u>my</u> God: 1 Chronicles 29:3 ESV

and for all the work to be done by craftsmen, gold for the things of gold and silver for the things of silver. Who then will offer willingly, consecrating himself today to the Lord ?" Then the leaders of fathers' houses made their freewill offerings, as did also the leaders of the tribes, the commanders of thousands and of hundreds, and the officers over the king's work.
