⁶ And without faith it is impossible to please him,


⁷ By faith Noah, being warned by God concerning events as yet unseen, in reverent fear constructed an ark


²⁸ But if God so clothes the grass, which is alive in the field today, and tomorrow is thrown into the oven, how much more will he clothe you, O you of little faith!


Luke 12: 28 (ESV)

⁵ Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding. ⁶ In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make straight your paths.








⁷ "See the man who would not make God his refuge, but trusted in the abundance of his riches and sought refuge in his own destruction!"

- controlled by God
- feels insecure but is very secure
- dependant on God

- grounded in yourself, government, leaders
 - self control
 - feels secure, false sense of security
 - independent of God

- doing God's Will
- This is big, God sees the bigger picture


Hope, faith & trust In other things
