






My love for you : God's love for us

John 15: 5-9 (NKJV)




⁸ By this My Father is glorified, that you

Four words:

1. **Commandments**

entole (en-tol-ay')

- injunction, that is, an authoritative prescription.
- commandment, precept (a rule for action or behaviour, especially obtained from moral thought)



Four words:

2. **Abide:**

meno- (men'-o)

- to stay (in a given place, state, relation or expectancy):

- abide, continue, dwell, endure, be present, remain, stand,

Four words:

3. Love:

agape⁻ (ag-ah'-pay)

- affection or benevolence (kindness, goodness, goodwill, compassion, thoughtfulness).
- specifically (plural) a love feast:
- (feast of) charity ([-ably]), dear, love.




Four words:

4. **Joy:**

chara (khar-ah')


- cheerfulness, that is, calm delight:

- gladness, X greatly, (X be exceeding) joy (-ful, -fully, -fulness, -ous).

in My compassion.

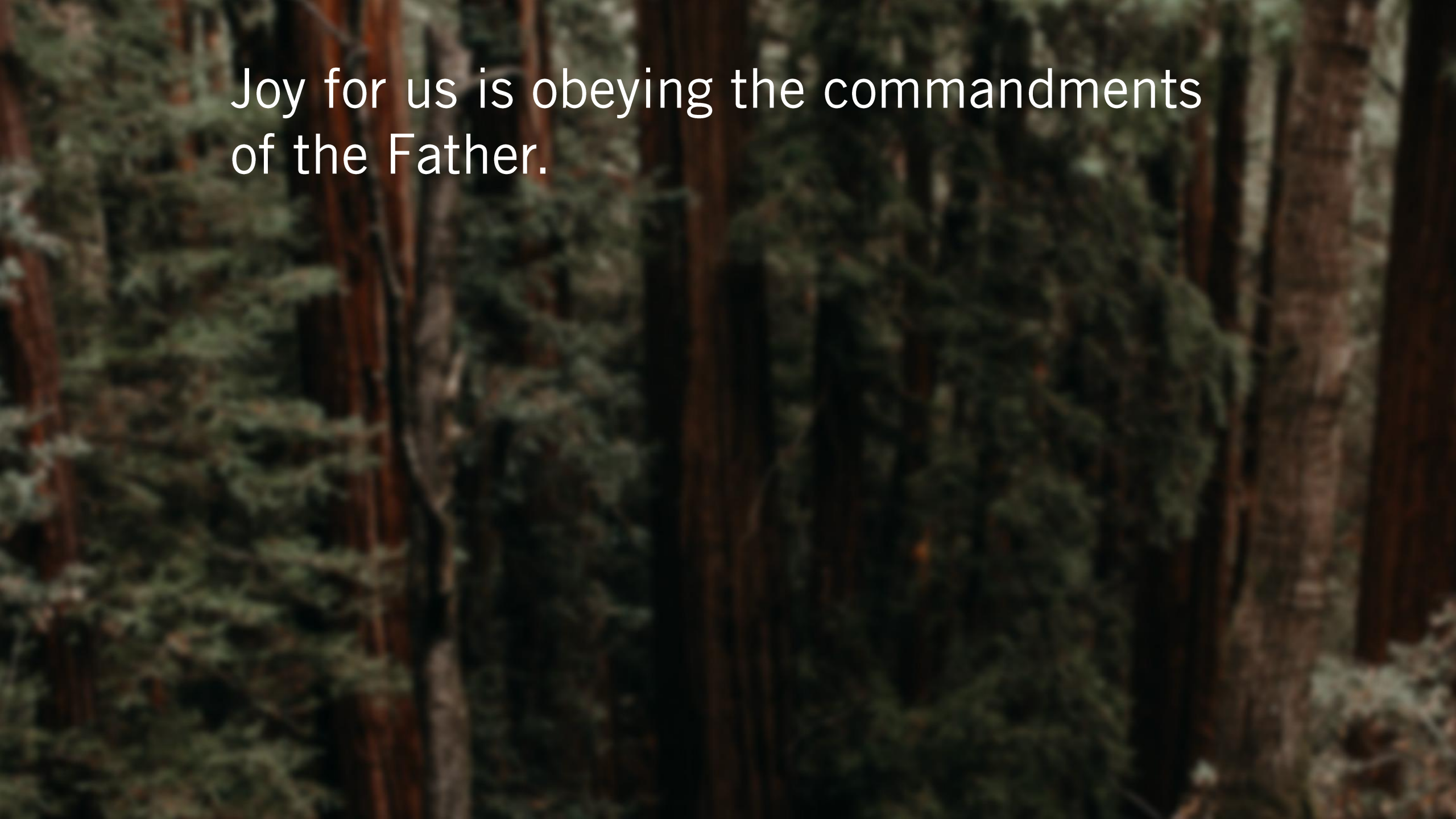
Just as I kept doing what My Father told

that your joy may be full.


This is the things what I am telling you






³ Blessed is he who reads and those who hear the words of this prophecy, and keep those things which are written in it; for the time is near.

Be master over all the things around them.



Sacrifice.


Intercede.
