<sup>11</sup> so shall my word be that goes out from my  
mouth;  
it shall not return to me empty,  
but it shall accomplish that which I purpose,  
and shall succeed in the thing for which I  
sent it.

Isaiah 55: 10-11 (ESV)

1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. <sup>2</sup> He was in the beginning with God.

<sup>14</sup> And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.

John 1: 1, 14 (NKJV)

<sup>1</sup> And He said to me, “Son of man, stand on your feet, and I will speak to you.” <sup>2</sup> Then the Spirit entered me when He spoke to me, and set me on my feet; and I heard Him who spoke to me. <sup>3</sup> And He said to me: “Son of man, I am sending you to the children of Israel, to a rebellious nation that has rebelled against Me; they and their fathers have transgressed against Me to this very day.

Ezekiel 2 (NKJV)

<sup>4</sup> For they are impudent and stubborn children. I am sending you to them, and you shall say to them, 'Thus says the Lord GOD.' <sup>5</sup> As for them, whether they hear or whether they refuse—for they are a rebellious house—yet they will know that a prophet has been among them.

Ezekiel 2 (NKJV)

<sup>6</sup> “And you, son of man, do not be afraid of them nor be afraid of their words, though briers and thorns are with you and you dwell among scorpions; do not be afraid of their words or dismayed by their looks, though they are a rebellious house. <sup>7</sup> You shall speak My words to them, whether they hear or whether they refuse, for they are rebellious.

Ezekiel 2 (NKJV)

<sup>8</sup> But you, son of man, hear what I say to you. Do not be rebellious like that rebellious house; open your mouth and eat what I give you.” <sup>9</sup> Now when I looked, there was a hand stretched out to me; and behold, a scroll of a book was in it. <sup>10</sup> Then He spread it before me; and there was writing on the inside and on the outside, and written on it were lamentations and mourning and woe.

Ezekiel 2 (NKJV)

<sup>1</sup> Moreover He said to me, “Son of man, eat what you find; eat this scroll, and go, speak to the house of Israel.” <sup>2</sup> So I opened my mouth, and He caused me to eat that scroll. <sup>3</sup> And He said to me, “Son of man, feed your belly, and fill your stomach with this scroll that I give you.” So I ate, and it was in my mouth like honey in sweetness.

Ezekiel 3 (NKJV)

<sup>4</sup> Then He said to me: “Son of man, go to the house of Israel and speak with My words to them. <sup>5</sup> For you are not sent to a people of unfamiliar speech and of hard language, but to the house of Israel, <sup>6</sup> not to many people of unfamiliar speech and of hard language, whose words you cannot understand.

Ezekiel 3 (NKJV)

Surely, had I sent you to them, they would have listened to you. <sup>7</sup> But the house of Israel will not listen to you, because they will not listen to Me; for all the house of Israel are impudent and hard-hearted.

Ezekiel 3 (NKJV)

<sup>8</sup> Behold, I have made your face strong against their faces, and your forehead strong against their foreheads. <sup>9</sup> Like adamant stone, harder than flint, I have made your forehead; do not be afraid of them, nor be dismayed at their looks, though they are a rebellious house.”

Ezekiel 3 (NKJV)

<sup>10</sup> Moreover He said to me: “Son of man, receive into your heart all My words that I speak to you, and hear with your ears. <sup>11</sup> And go, get to the captives, to the children of your people, and speak to them and tell them, ‘Thus says the Lord GOD,’ whether they hear, or whether they refuse.”

Ezekiel 3 (NKJV)

<sup>7</sup> And when they had set them in the midst, they asked, “By what power or by what name have you done this?”

<sup>10</sup> let it be known to you all, and to all the people of Israel, that by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom you crucified, whom God raised from the dead, by Him this man stands here before you whole.

Acts 4: 7, 10 (NKJV)

<sup>13</sup> Now when they saw the boldness of Peter and John, and perceived that they were uneducated and untrained men, they marveled. And they realized that they had been with Jesus.

Acts 4: 13 (NKJV)

<sup>46</sup> Now they came to Jericho. As He went out of Jericho with His disciples and a great multitude, blind Bartimaeus, the son of Timaeus, sat by the road begging. <sup>47</sup> And when he heard that it was Jesus of Nazareth, he began to cry out and say, “Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!” <sup>48</sup> Then many warned him to be quiet; but he cried out all the more, “Son of David, have mercy on me!”

Mark 10: 46 -52 (NKJV)

<sup>49</sup> So Jesus stood still and commanded him to be called. Then they called the blind man, saying to him, “Be of good cheer. Rise, He is calling you.”

<sup>50</sup> And throwing aside his garment, he rose and came to Jesus.

Mark 10: 46 -52 (NKJV)

<sup>51</sup> So Jesus answered and said to him, “What do you want Me to do for you?” The blind man said to Him, “Rabboni, that I may receive my sight.”

<sup>52</sup> Then Jesus said to him, “Go your way; your faith has made you well.” And immediately he received his sight and followed Jesus on the road.

28 But He said, Blessed (happy and to be envied) rather are those who hear the Word of God and obey and practice it!
