- British *informal* A friendly form of address.

- in tennis, squash, and some other sports,

make love to. Pay amorous attention to (someone).

- not for love or money

informal Not in any circumstances.

- there's no (or little or not much) love lost between. There is mutual dislike between (the people mentioned)

- fall in love.

Develop a deep romantic or sexual attachment to someone.



- fall out of love

Cease to feel a deep romantic or sexual attachment to someone.


