




2 Thessalonians 2: 13 (NKJV)






James 2: 19 (NKJV)

Even the demons believe—and tremble!






Deuteronomy 6: 4 – 5 (NKJV)

<sup>5</sup> You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength.






Mark 3: 11 (NKJV)

“You are the Son of God.”






James 2: 17 (NKJV)

is dead.

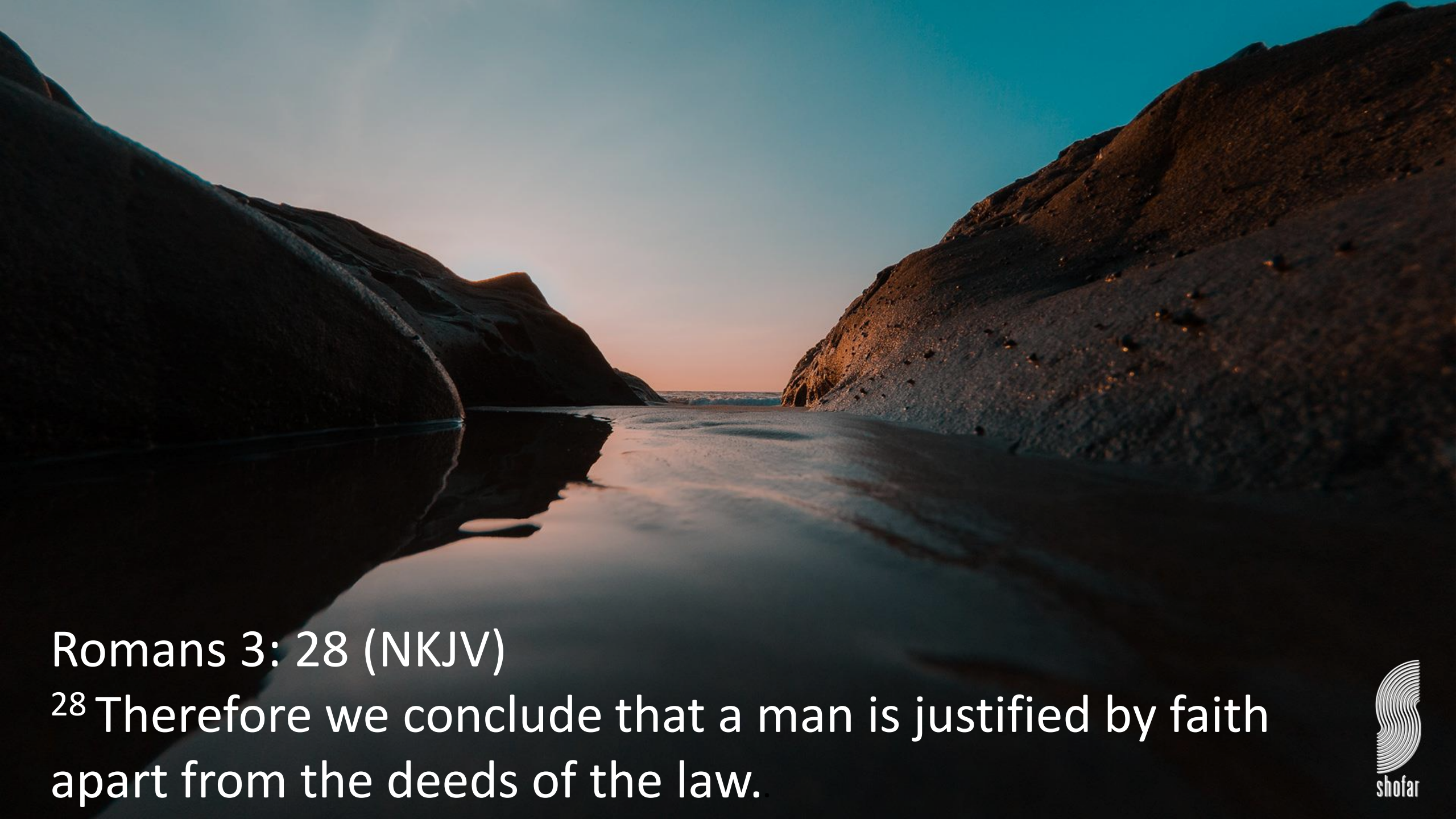




James 2: 26 (NKJV)

Romans 3: 28 (NKJV)


<sup>28</sup> Therefore we conclude that a man is justified by faith

James after a man is converted,






Mark 16: 14 – 18 (NKJV)


