



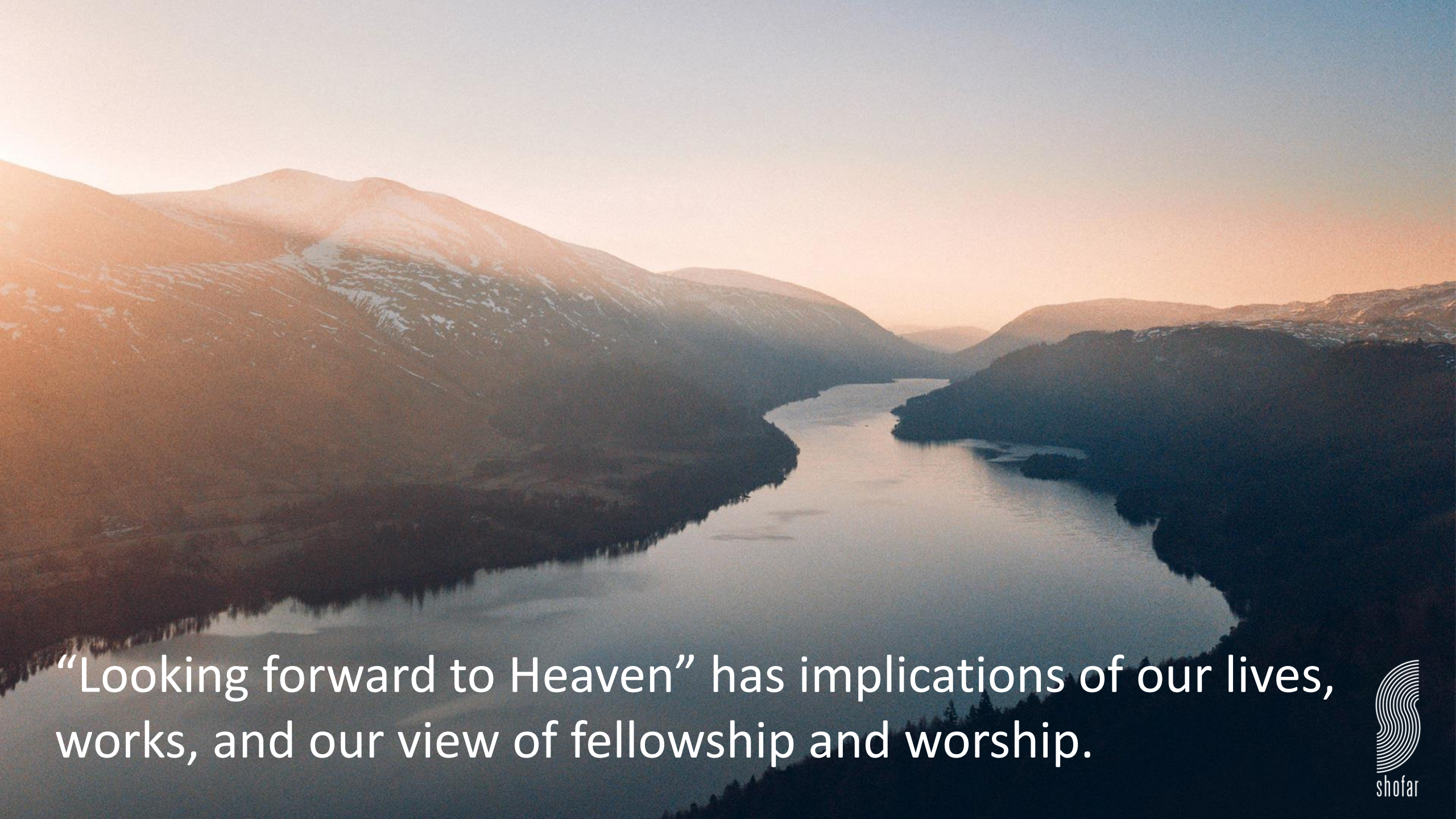

“Looking forward to Heaven” has implications of our lives, works, and our view of fellowship and worship.

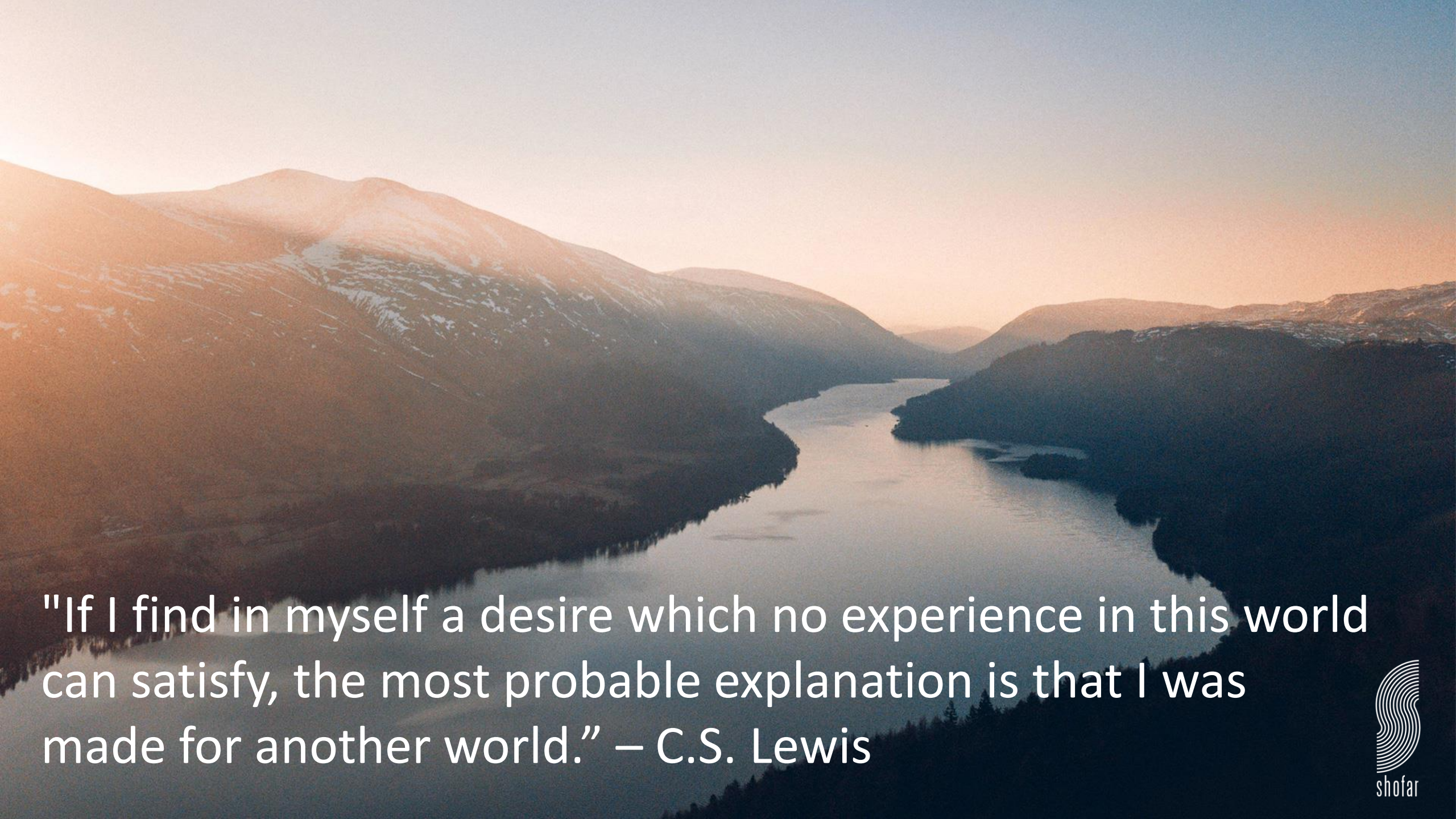




We are confident of Heaven because:
