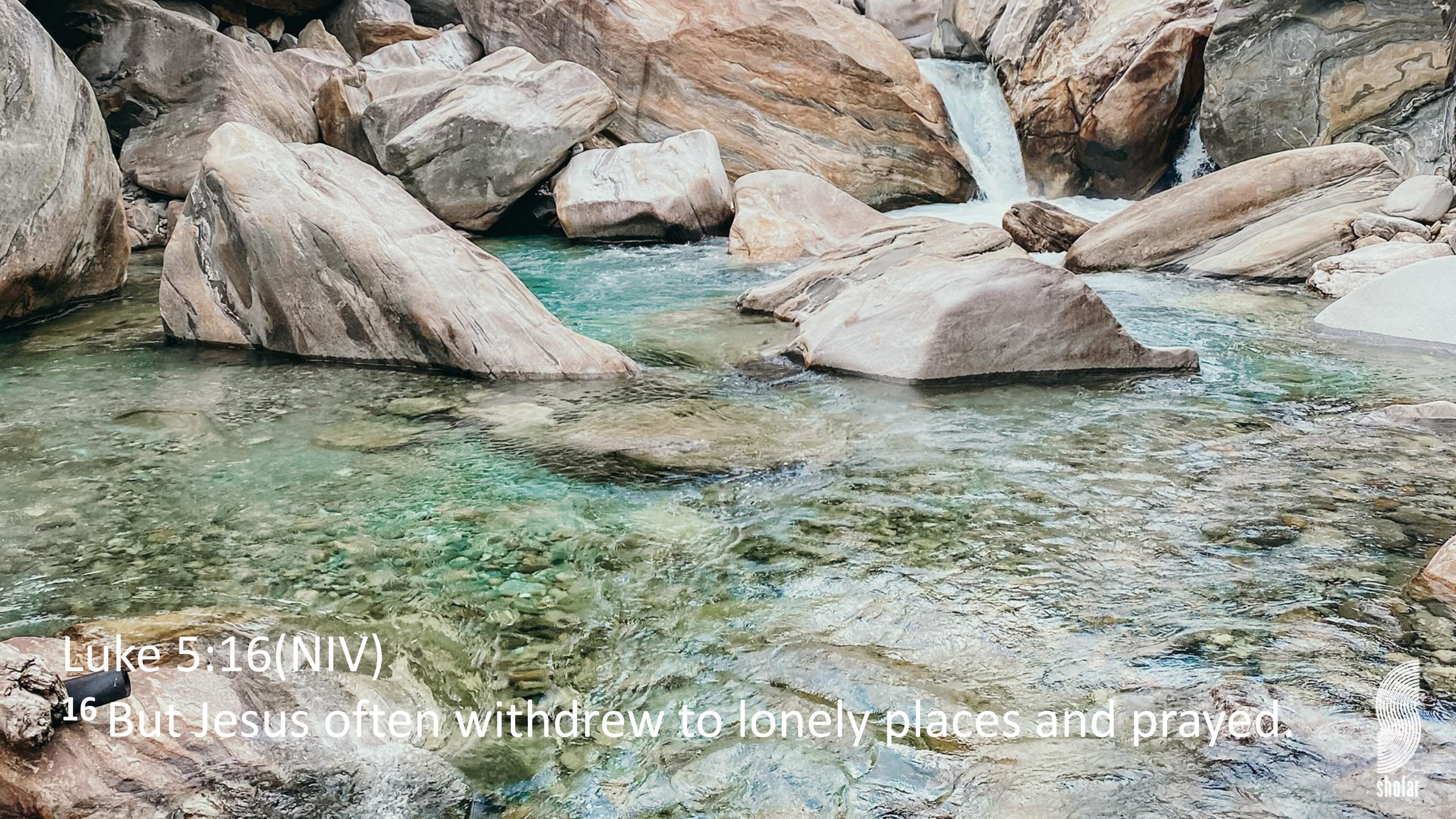




Luke 11:1(NIV)

11 One day Jesus was praying in a certain place. When he finished, one of his disciples said to him, “Lord, teach us to pray, just as John taught his disciples.”

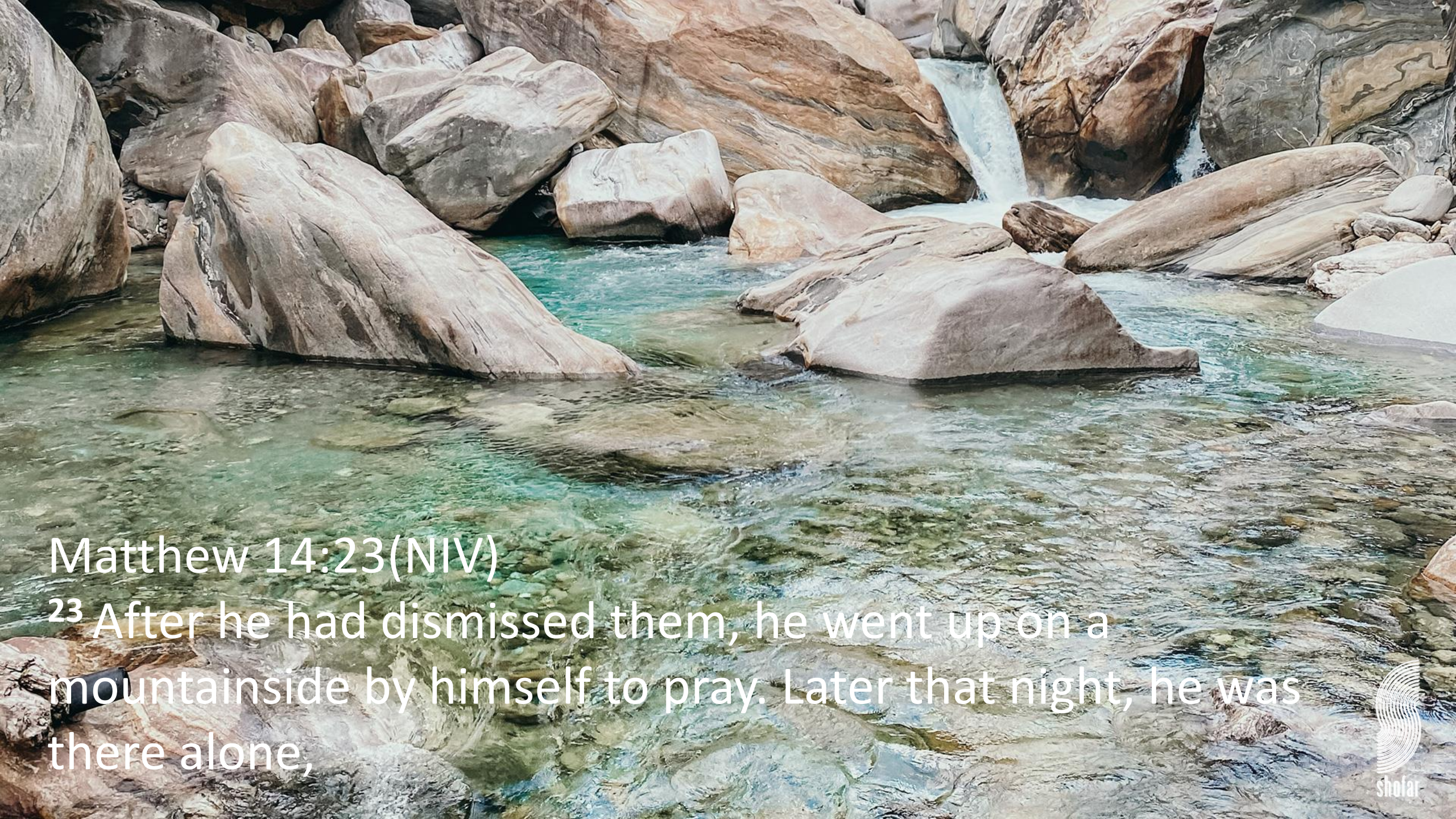




Luke 5:16(NIV)

<sup>16</sup> But Jesus often withdrew to lonely places and prayed.

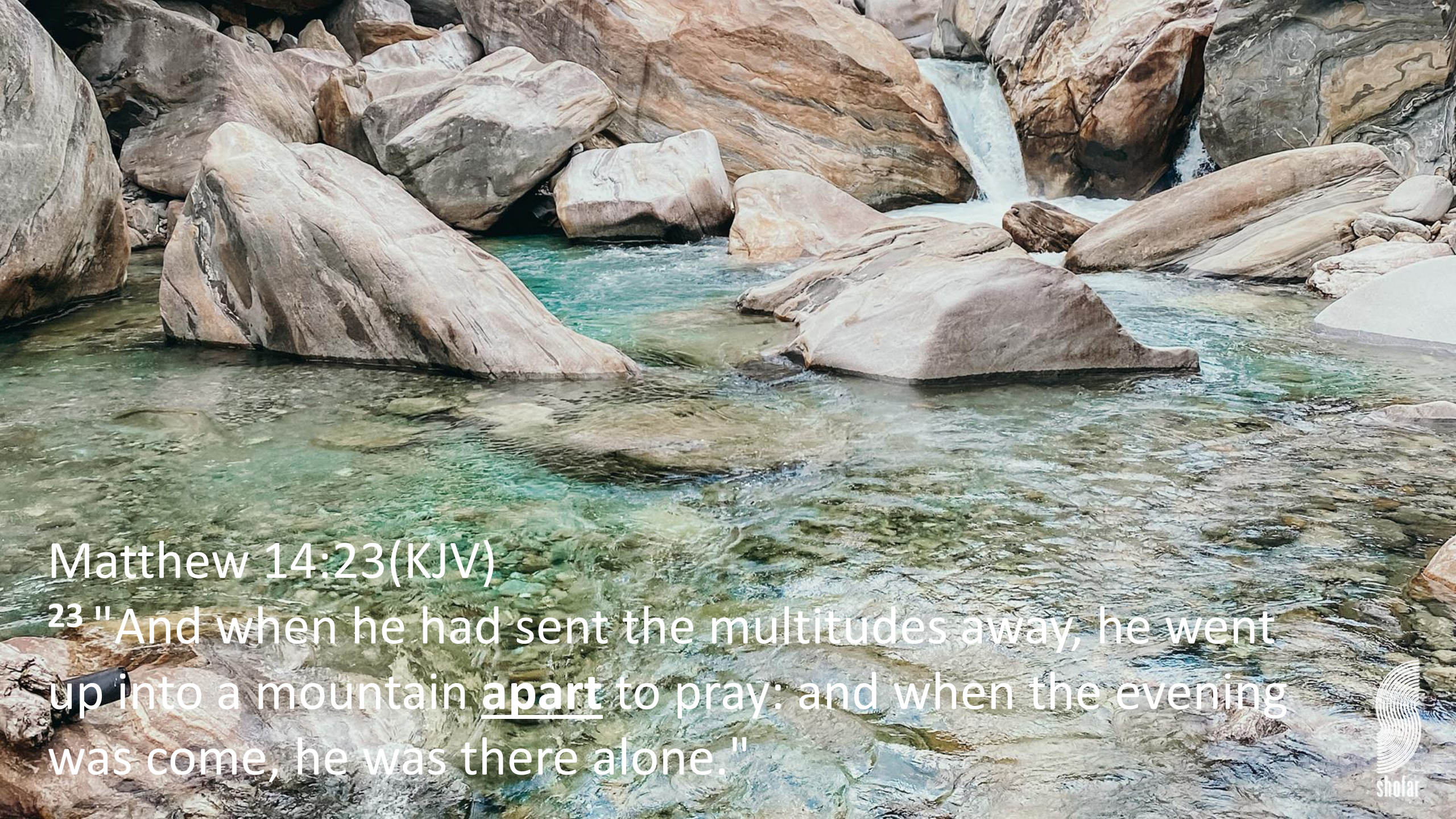




Matthew 14:23(NIV)

<sup>23</sup> "And when he had sent the multitudes away, he went up into a mountain apart to pray: and when the evening was come, he was there alone."

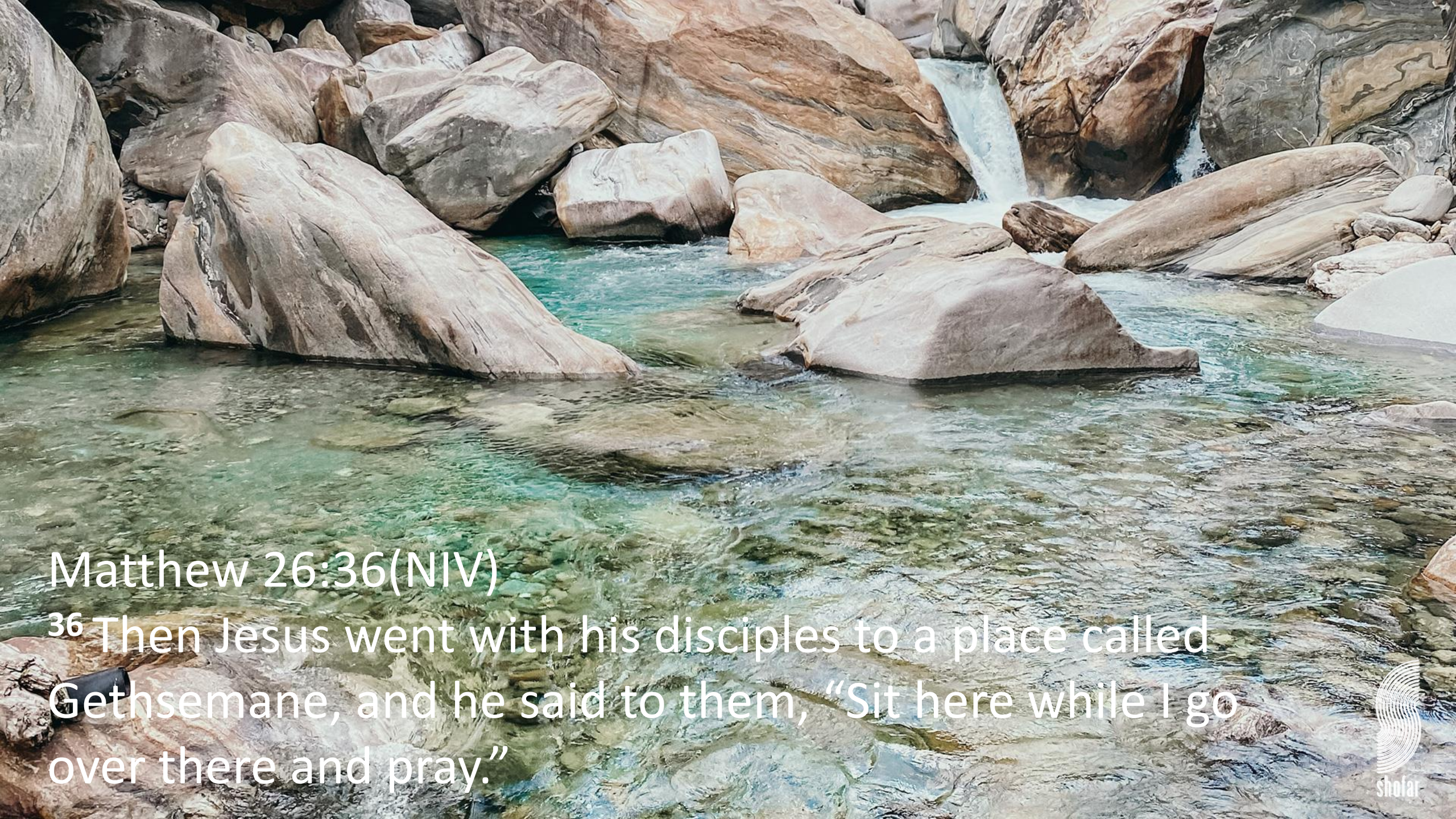




Luke 6:12-13(NIV)






Matthew 26:36(NIV)

<sup>36</sup> Then Jesus went with his disciples to a place called Gethsemane, and he said to them, “Sit here while I go over there and pray.”






Luke 18:1-8(NIV)






Luke 18:1-8(NIV)

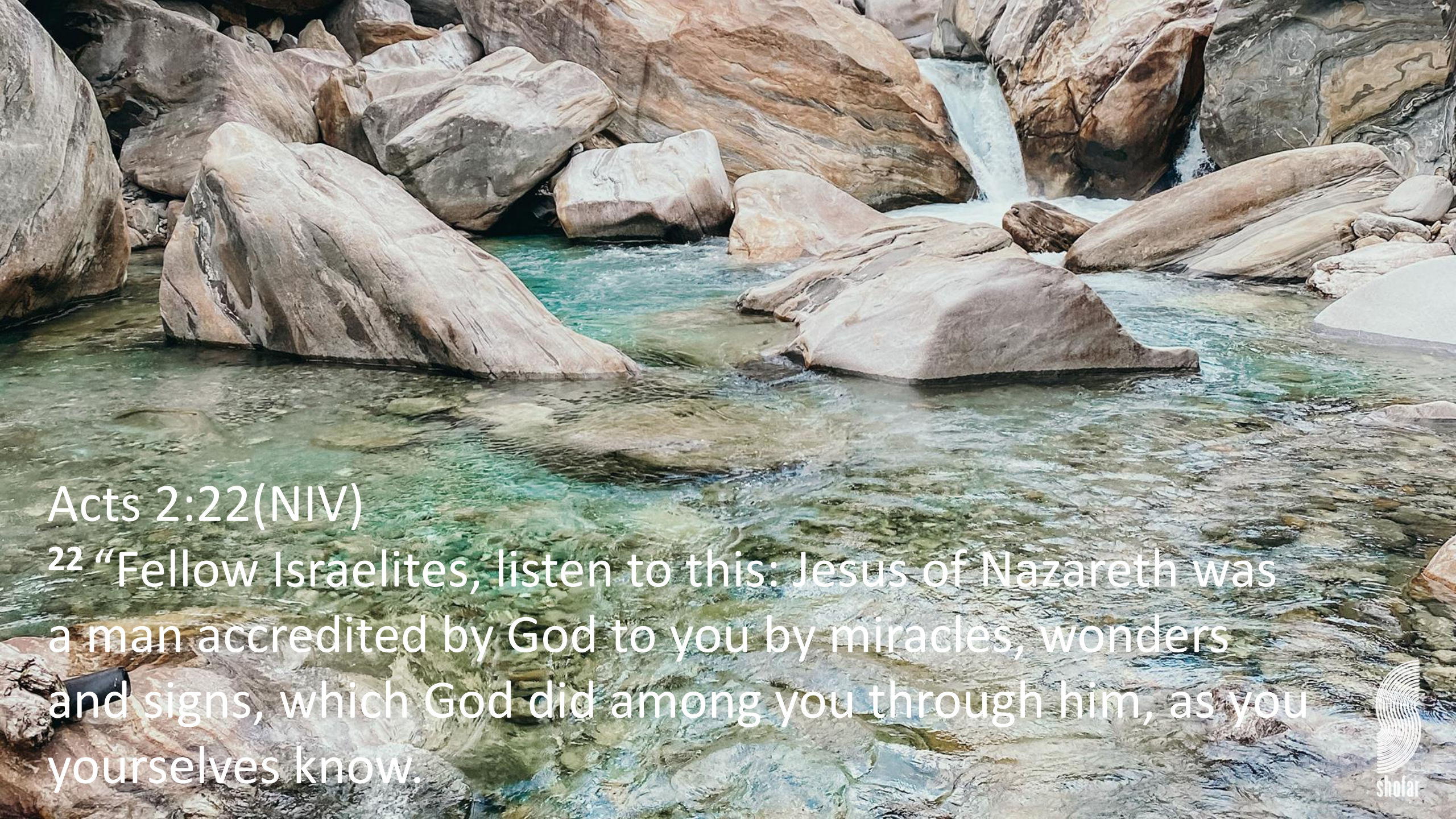




Luke 18:8(NIV)

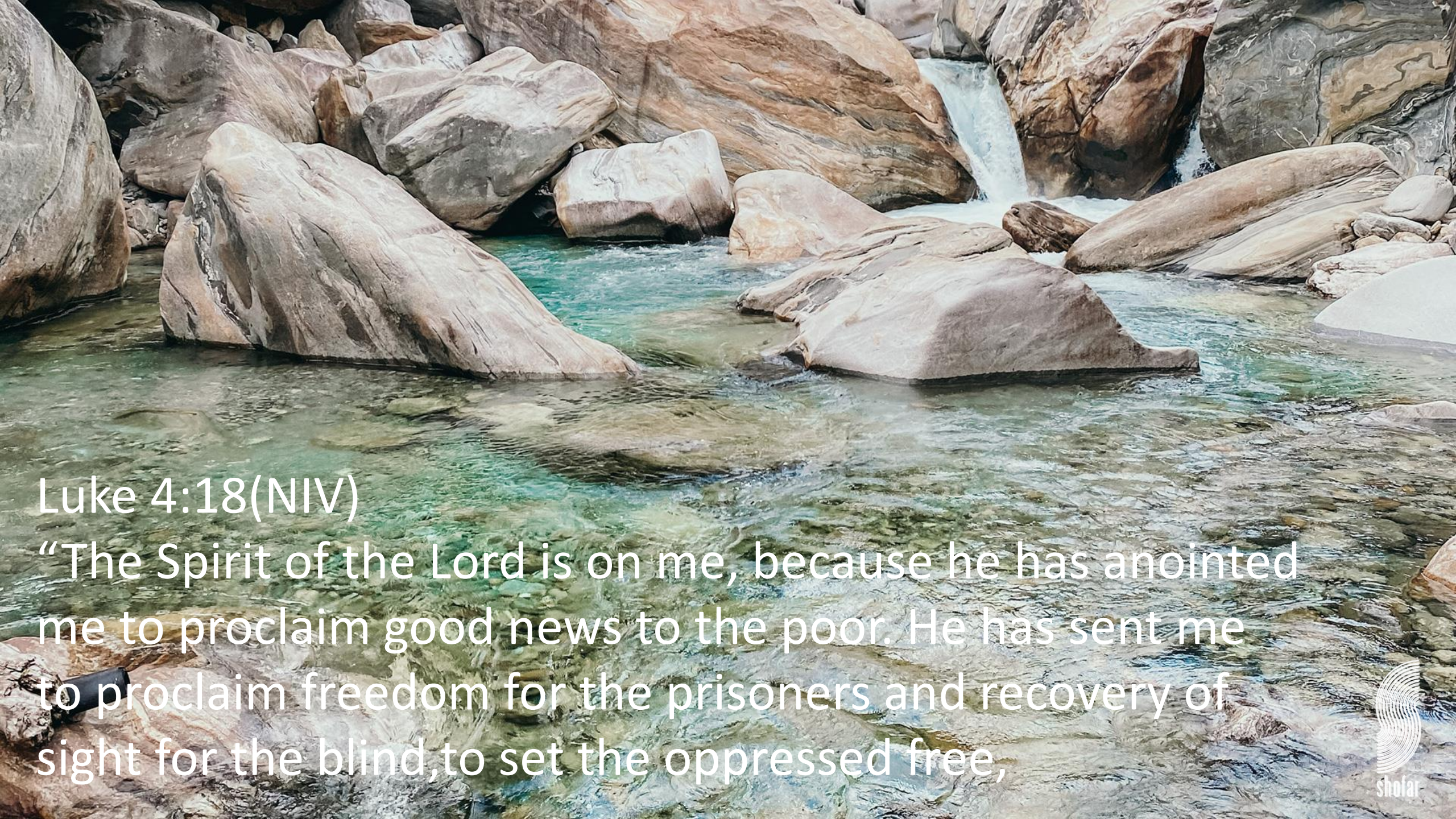


Sensitivity to the holy spirit :

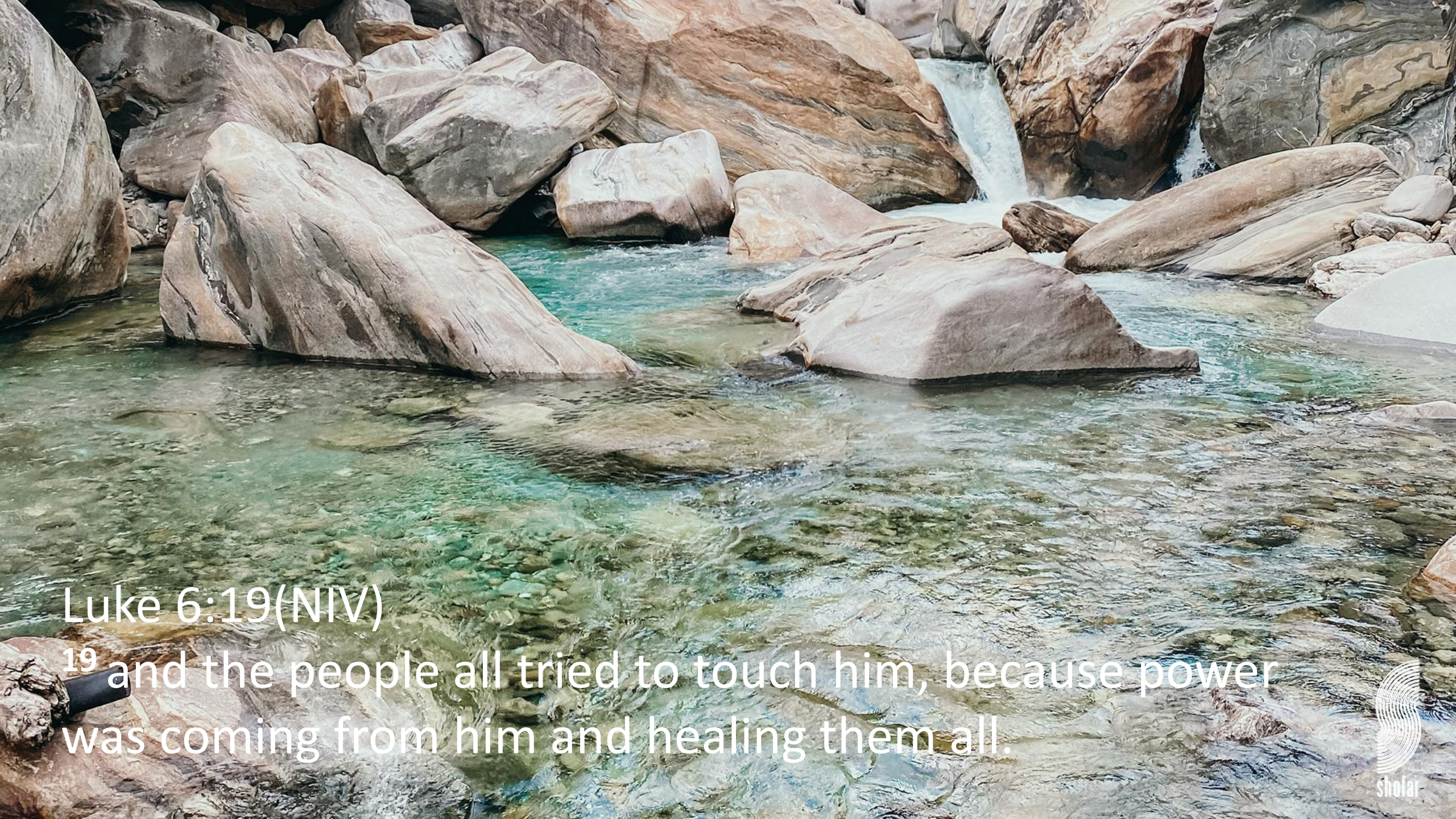




Luke 5:17(NIV)

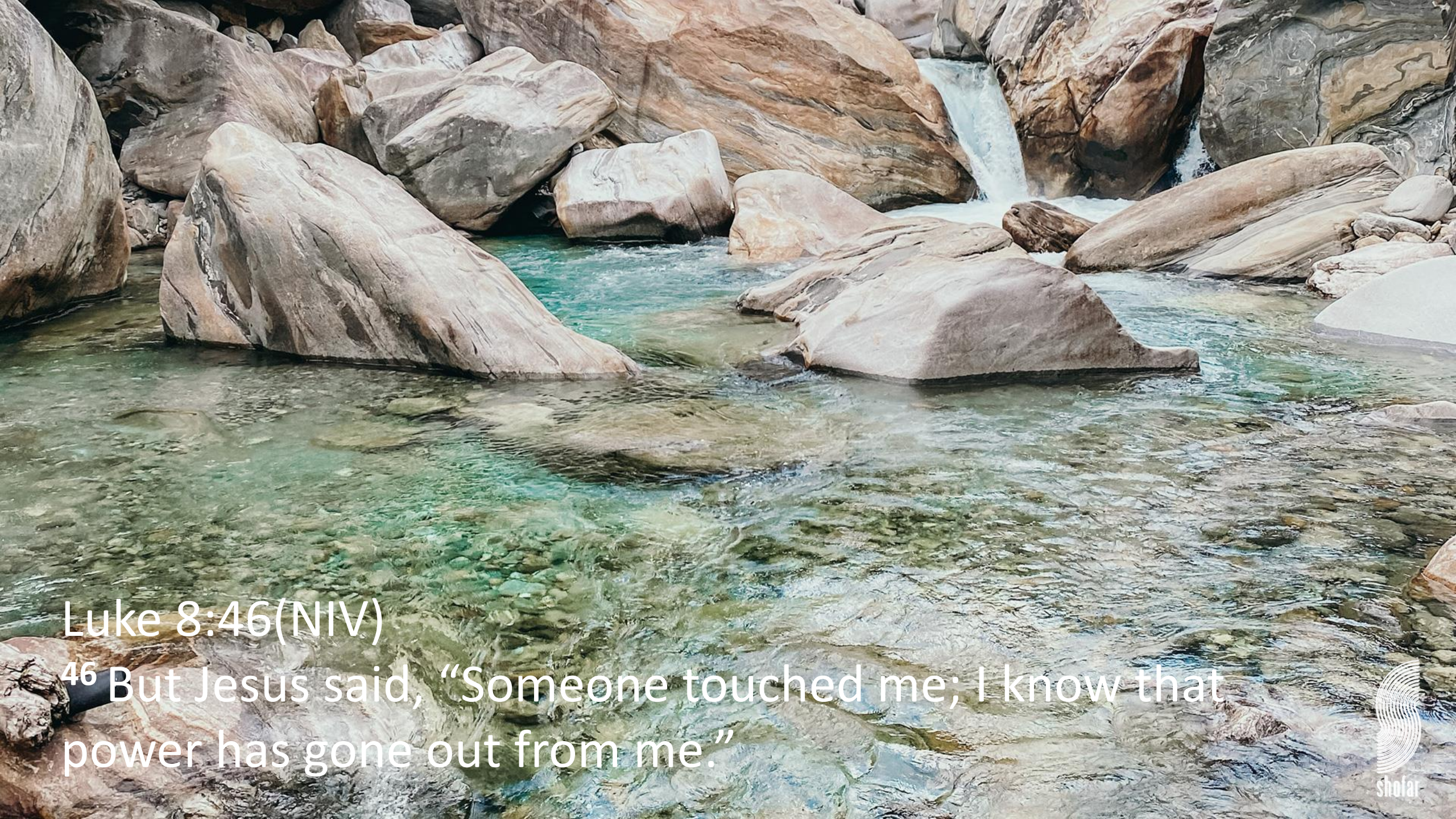




Luke 6:19(NIV)

<sup>19</sup> and the people all tried to touch him, because power was coming from him and healing them all.

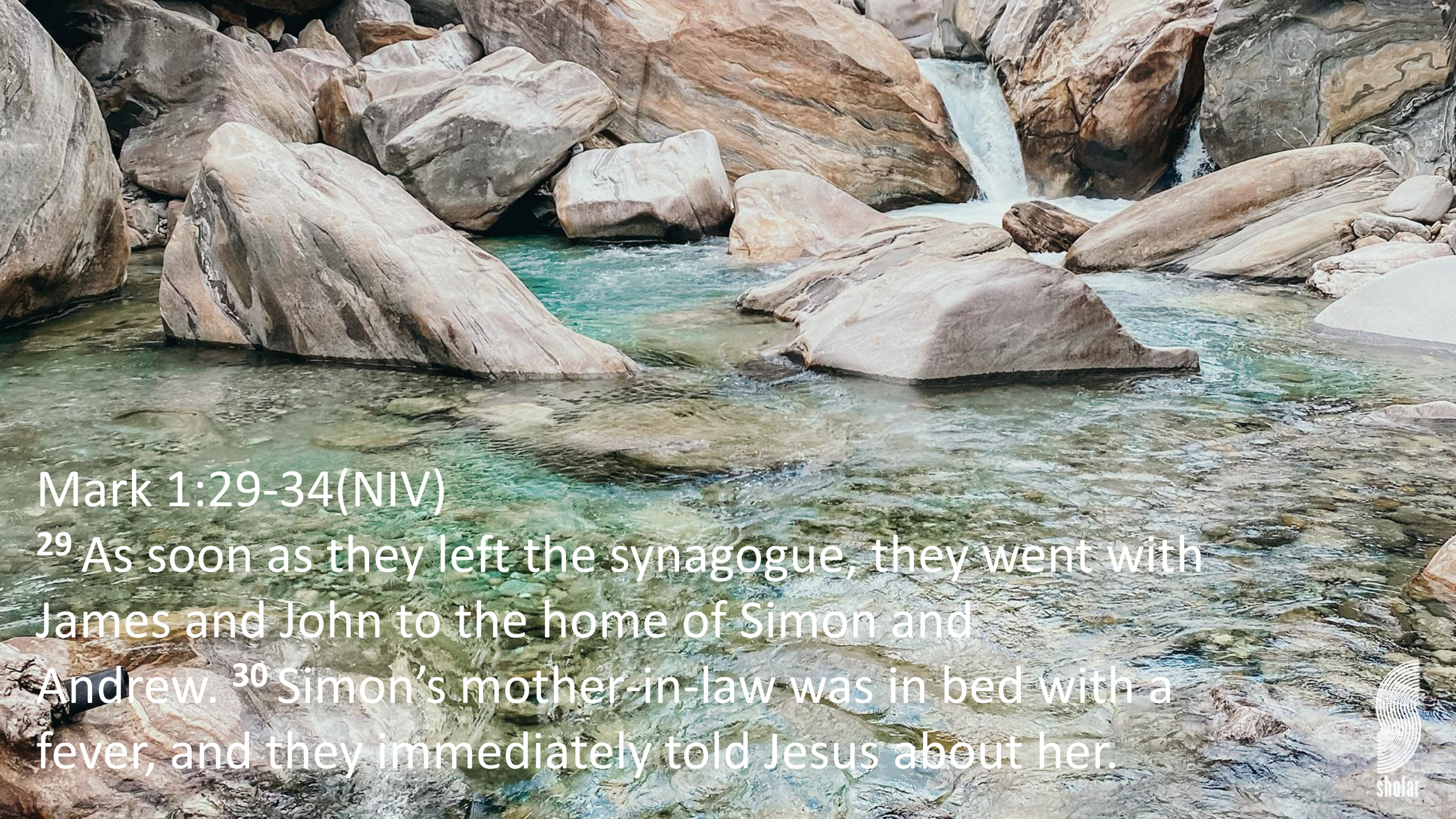




Luke 8:46(NIV)

<sup>46</sup> But Jesus said, "Someone touched me; I know that power has gone out from me."

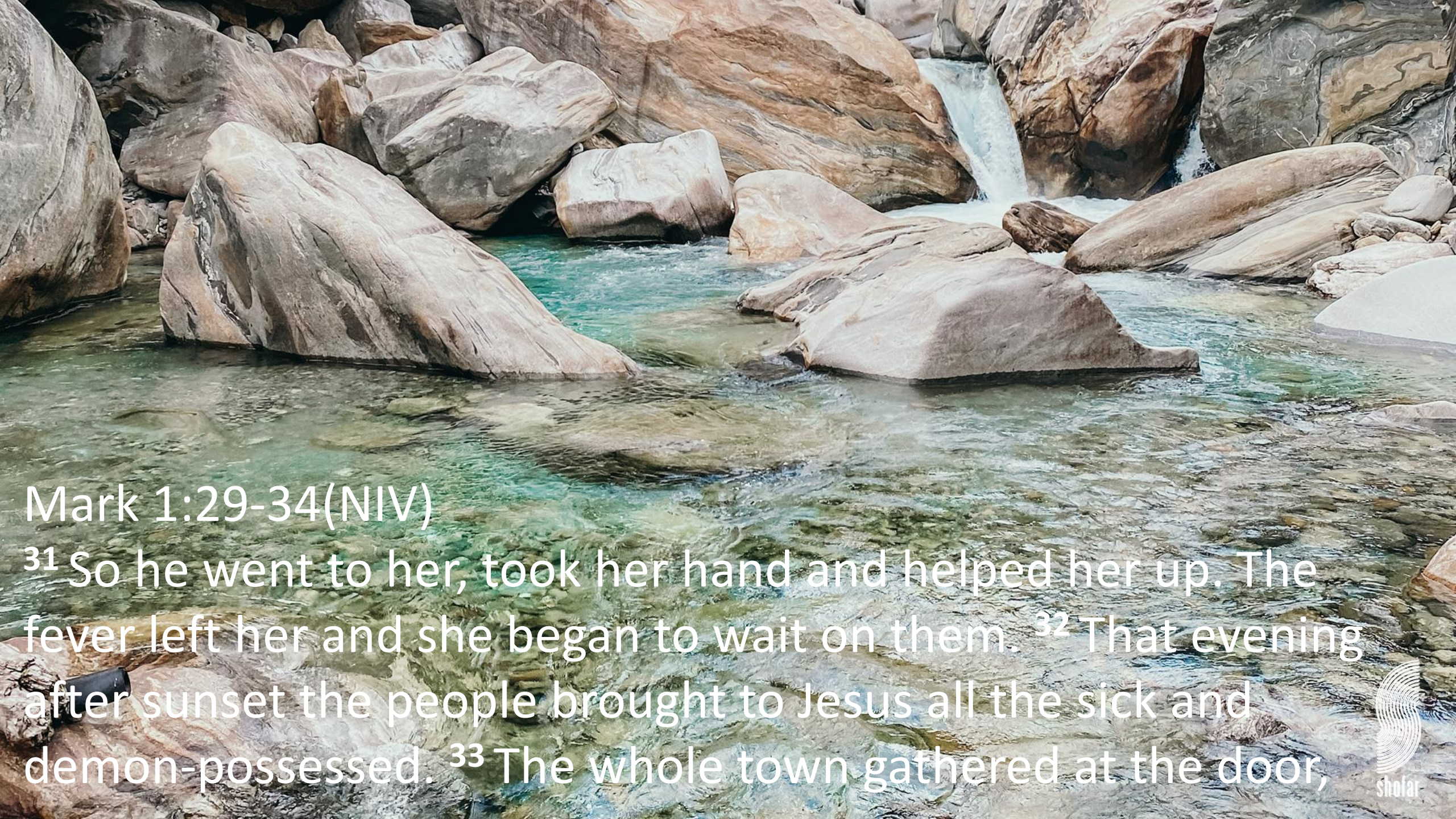




Mark 1:29-34(NIV)

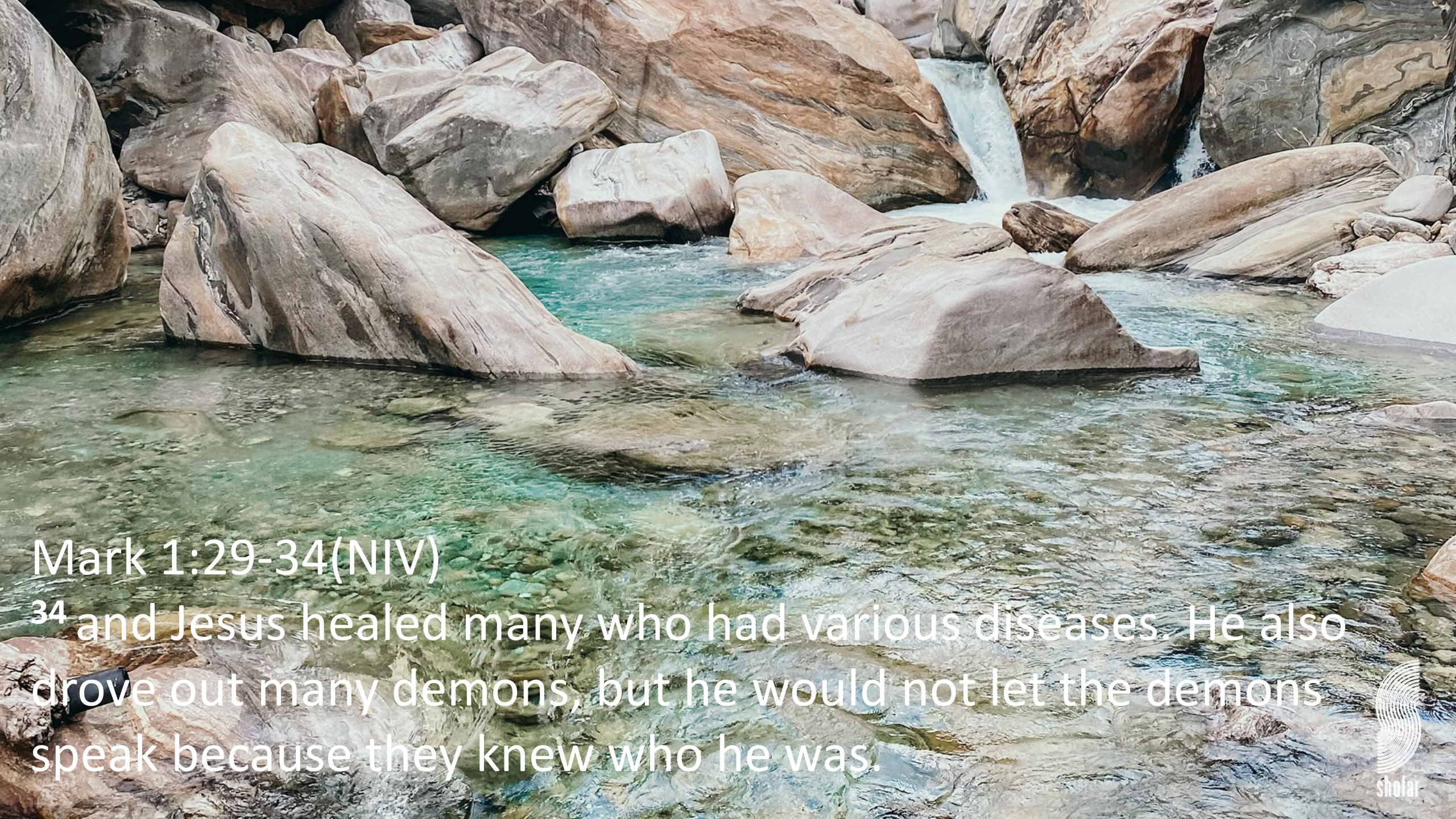




Mark 1:29-34(NIV)

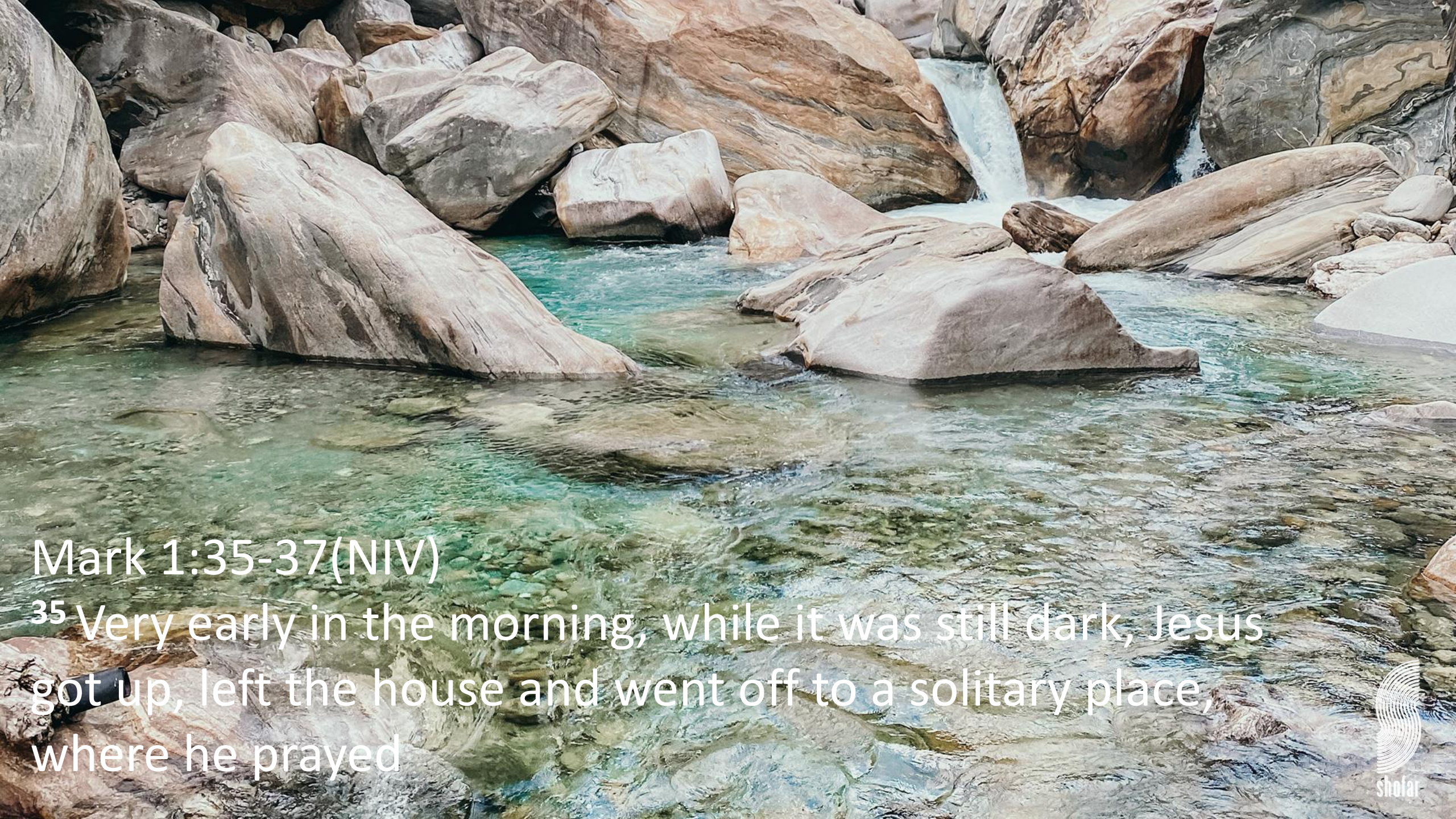




Mark 1:29-34(NIV)

<sup>34</sup> and Jesus healed many who had various diseases. He also drove out many demons, but he would not let the demons speak because they knew who he was.

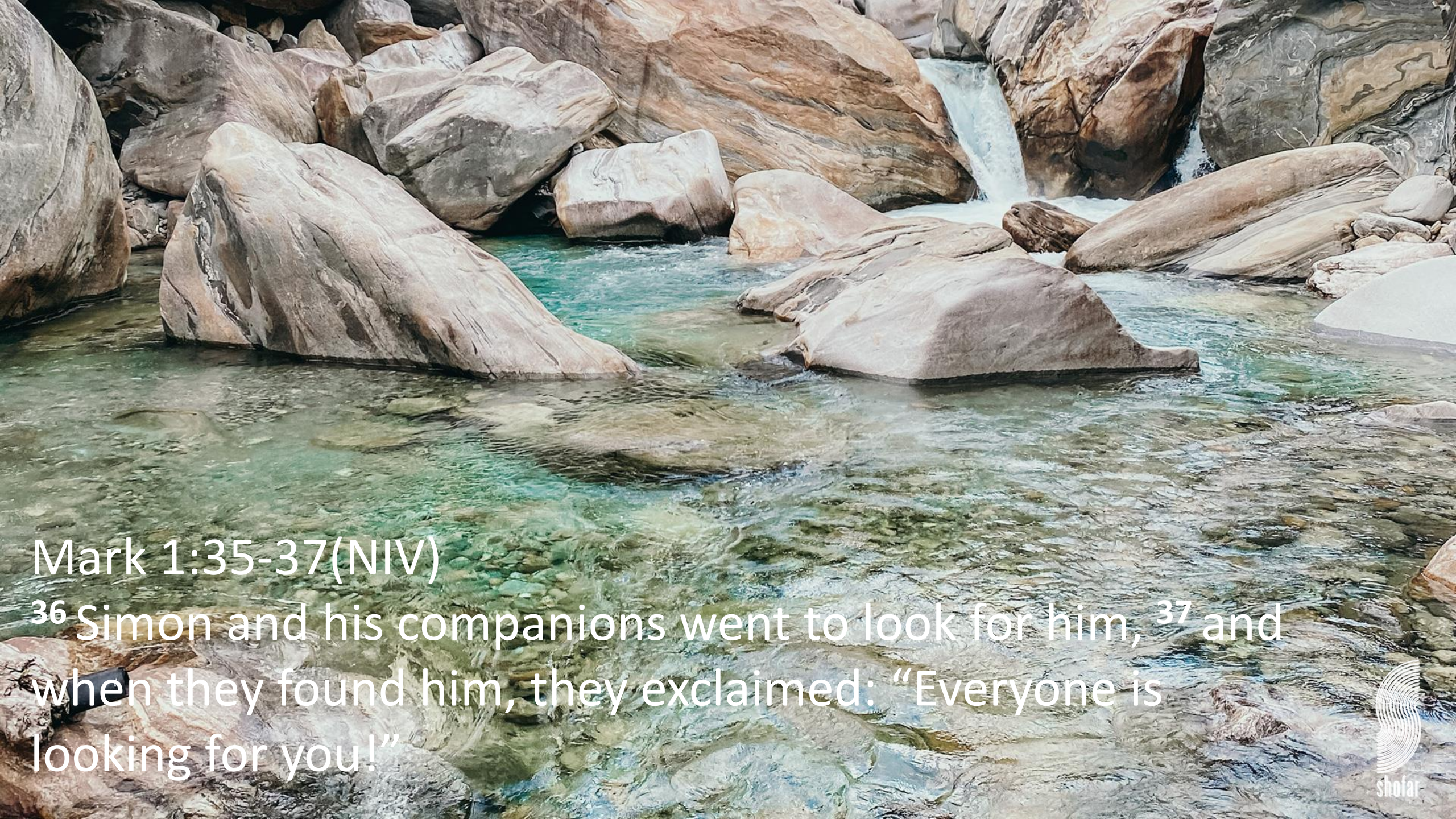




Mark 1:35-37(NIV)
