




Deuteronomy 21: 18 – 21 (NKJV)


¹⁸ “If a man has a stubborn and rebellious son who will not obey the voice of his father or the voice of his mother, and who, when they have chastened him, will not heed them,




¹⁹ then his father and his mother shall take hold of him

²¹ Then all the men of his city shall stone him to death with stones; so you shall put away the evil from among you, and all Israel shall hear and fear.





²² Then you shall say to Pharaoh, ‘Thus says the LORD: “Israel is My son, My firstborn.




Hosea 11: 1-2, 7 (NKJV)


¹ “When Israel was a child, I loved him,

None at all exalt Him.





He also has rejected you from being king.”




¹⁸ For John came neither eating nor drinking, and they say, 'He has a demon.'
