**ROMANS 12: 18 (NIV)** 

<sup>12</sup>If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at <u>peace with</u> <u>everyone</u>

ROMANS 5: 1 (ESV)

Therefore, since we have been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.

**ROMANS 5: 10 (ESV)** 

<sup>10</sup>For if while we were enemies we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, now that we are reconciled, shall we be saved by his life.

## PHILIPPIANS 4: 6 - 7 (ESV)

<sup>6</sup>do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. <sup>7</sup>And the <u>peace of God</u>, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

ACTS 12: 1-6

<sup>1</sup>About that time Herod the king laid violent hands on some who belonged to the church. <sup>2</sup>He killed James the brother of John with the sword, <sup>3</sup>and when he saw that it pleased the Jews, he proceeded to arrest Peter also. This was during the days of Unleavened Bread.

ACTS 12: 1-6

<sup>4</sup>And when he had seized him, he put him in prison, delivering him over to four squads of soldiers to guard him, intending after the Passover to bring him out to the people. <sup>5</sup>So Peter was kept in prison, but earnest prayer for him was made to God by the church.

ACTS 12: 1-6

<sup>6</sup>Now when Herod was about to bring him out, on that very night, Peter was sleeping between two soldiers, bound with two chains, and sentries before the door were guarding the prison.

PSALM 4: 8 (ESV)

<sup>8</sup>In peace I will both lie down and sleep; for you alone, O Lord, make me dwell in safety.

**GALATIANS 5: 22 - 23 (ESV)** 

<sup>22</sup>But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, <sup>23</sup>gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law.

#### 2 THESSALONIANS 3: 16 (ESV)

<sup>16</sup>Now may the Lord of peace himself give you peace at all times in every way. The Lord be with you all.

## PHILIPPIANS 4: 6 - 7 (ESV)

COLOSSIANS 3: 12, 15 (ESV)


<sup>15</sup>And let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, to which indeed you were called in one body. And be thankful.

So unstable and unsure


And calmness to our souls,
