Genesis 27:19 (NIV)


19 Jacob said to his father, "I am Esau your firstborn. I have done as you told me. Please sit up and eat some of my game, so that you may give me your blessing."

20 Then Jacob made a vow, saying, "If God will be with me and will watch over me on this journey ...21 so that I return safely to my father's household, then the Lord will be my God








Isaiah 64:8 (NIV) 8 Yet you, Lord, are our Father. We are the clay, you are the potter; we are all the work of your hand.




Proverbs 27:17 (NIV)
