³⁸ Now the just shall live by faith;
But if anyone draws back,
My soul has no pleasure in him.”



³⁹ But we are not of those who draw back to perdition,
but of those who believe to the saving of the soul.



Hebrew 10:39 (AMPC)

³⁹ But our way is not that of those who draw back to eternal misery (perdition) and are utterly destroyed, but we are of those who believe [who cleave to and trust in and rely on God through Jesus Christ, the Messiah] and by faith preserve the soul.



Hebrews 11: 1 – 40 (NKJV)

¹ Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. ² For by it the elders obtained a good testimony.



³ By faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that the things which are seen were not made of things which are visible.



⁴ By faith Abel offered to God a more excellent sacrifice than Cain, ..



⁵ By faith Enoch was taken away so that he did not see death, ..



⁶ But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.



⁷ By faith Noah, ..



⁸ By faith Abraham obeyed when he was called to go out to the place which he would receive as an inheritance. And he went out, not knowing where he was going.



⁹ By faith he dwelt in the land of promise as in a foreign country, ..



¹¹ By faith Sarah herself also received strength to conceive seed, and she bore a child when she was past the age, because she judged Him faithful who had promised.



¹³ These all died in faith, not having received the promises, but having seen them afar off were assured of them, embraced them and confessed that they were strangers and pilgrims on the earth.



¹⁴ For those who say such things declare plainly that they seek a homeland. ¹⁵ And truly if they had called to mind that country from which they had come out, they would have had opportunity to return.



¹⁶ But now they desire a better, that is, a heavenly country. Therefore God is not ashamed to be called their God, for He has prepared a city for them.



¹⁷ By faith Abraham, when he was tested, offered up Isaac, ..



²⁰ By faith Isaac blessed Jacob and Esau concerning things to come.



²¹ By faith Jacob, when he was dying, blessed each of the sons of Joseph,



²² By faith Joseph, when he was dying, made mention of the departure of the children of Israel, and gave instructions concerning his bones.



²³ By faith Moses, when he was born, was hidden three months by his parents, ..



²⁴ By faith Moses, when he became of age, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter,



²⁵ choosing rather to suffer affliction with the people of
God than to enjoy the passing pleasures of sin,
²⁶ esteeming the reproach of Christ greater riches than
the treasures in Egypt; for he looked to the reward.



²⁷ By faith he forsook Egypt, not fearing the wrath of the king; for he endured as seeing Him who is invisible.



²⁹ By faith they passed through the Red Sea as by dry land, whereas the Egyptians, attempting to do so, were drowned.



³⁰ By faith the walls of Jericho fell down after they were encircled for seven days.



³¹ By faith the harlot Rahab did not perish with those who did not believe, when she had received the spies with peace.



³⁹ And all these, having obtained a good testimony through faith, did not receive the promise, ⁴⁰ God having provided something better for us, that they should not be made perfect apart from us.



Hebrews 12: 1 – 2 (NKJV)

¹ Therefore we also, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which so easily ensnares us, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us,



² looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.
