Tools: handy to have or good to know



1. Discipline and discipling



Proverbs 22: 6 (ESV) Train up a child in the way he should go; even when he is old he will not depart from it.



Proverbs 29: 17 (ESV) Discipline your son, and he will give you rest; he will give delight to your heart.



Hebrew 12: 5 – 8 (ESV)

⁵ And have you forgotten the exhortation that addresses you as sons?

"My son, do not regard lightly the discipline of the Lord, nor be weary when reproved by him.



Hebrew 12: 5 – 8 (ESV) ⁶ For the Lord disciplines the one he loves, and chastises every son whom he receives."



⁷ It is for discipline that you have to endure. God is treating you as sons. For what son is there whom his father does not discipline? ⁸ If you are left without discipline, in which all have participated, then you are illegitimate children and not sons.



Revelations 3: 16, 19 (ESV)

¹⁶ So, because you are lukewarm, and neither hot nor cold, I will spit you out of my mouth. ¹⁹ Those whom I love, I reprove and discipline, so be zealous and repent.





2. Authority



Luke 20: 1, 2 (ESV)

¹ One day, as Jesus was teaching the people in the temple and preaching the gospel, the chief priests and the scribes with the elders came up ² and said to him, "Tell us by what authority you do these things, or who it is that gave you this authority."



Luke 10: 19 (ESV) ¹⁹ Behold, I have given you authority to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall hurt you.





3. Faith

Joshua 1: 9 (ESV)

⁹ Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be frightened, and do not be dismayed, for the LORD your God is with you wherever you go."



Hebrews 13: 5 (ESV)

⁵ Keep your life free from love of money, and be content with what you have, for he has said, "I will never leave you nor forsake you."



Matthew 28: 20 (ESV)

²⁰ teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age."





4. Prayer

James 5: 15, 16 (ESV)

¹⁵ And the prayer of faith will save the one who is sick, and the Lord will raise him up. And if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven. ¹⁶ Therefore, confess your sins to one another and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person has great power as it is working.





5. Endurance

Hebrews 12: 1 (ESV)

¹Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight, and sin which clings so closely, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us,



Hebrews 10: 36 (ESV)

³⁶ For you have need of endurance, so that when you have done the will of God you may receive what is promised.




8. Jesus Christ
