## Matthew 28: 16 – 17 (NKJV)

<sup>16</sup> Then the eleven disciples went away into Galilee, to the mountain which Jesus had appointed for them. <sup>17</sup> When they saw Him, they worshiped Him; but some doubted.



Luke 10: 18 – 20 (NKJV)

<sup>18</sup> And He said to them, “I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven. <sup>19</sup> Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you.



Luke 10: 18 – 20 (NKJV)

<sup>20</sup> Nevertheless do not rejoice in this, that the spirits are subject to you, but rather rejoice because your names are written in heaven.”



## Genesis 3: 1 (NKJV)

<sup>1</sup> Now the serpent was more cunning than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said to the woman, “Has God indeed said, ‘You shall not eat of every tree of the garden’?”



John 12: 49 (NKJV)

<sup>49</sup> For I have not spoken on My own authority; but the Father who sent Me gave Me a command, what I should say and what I should speak.



Joshua 1: 11 (NKJV)

<sup>11</sup> “Pass through the camp and command the people, saying, ‘Prepare provisions for yourselves, for within three days you will cross over this Jordan, to go in to possess the land which the LORD your God is giving you to possess.’ ”





## Joshua 3: 14 – 17 (NKJV)

<sup>14</sup> So it was, when the people set out from their camp to cross over the Jordan, with the priests bearing the ark of the covenant before the people,



<sup>15</sup> and as those who bore the ark came to the Jordan,  
and the feet of the priests who bore the ark dipped in  
the edge of the water (for the Jordan overflows all its  
banks during the whole time of harvest),



<sup>16</sup> that the waters which came down from upstream stood still, and rose in a heap very far away at Adam, the city that is beside Zaretan. So the waters that went down into the Sea of the Arabah, the Salt Sea, failed, and were cut off; and the people crossed over opposite Jericho.



<sup>17</sup> Then the priests who bore the ark of the covenant of the LORD stood firm on dry ground in the midst of the Jordan; and all Israel crossed over on dry ground, until all the people had crossed completely over the Jordan.
