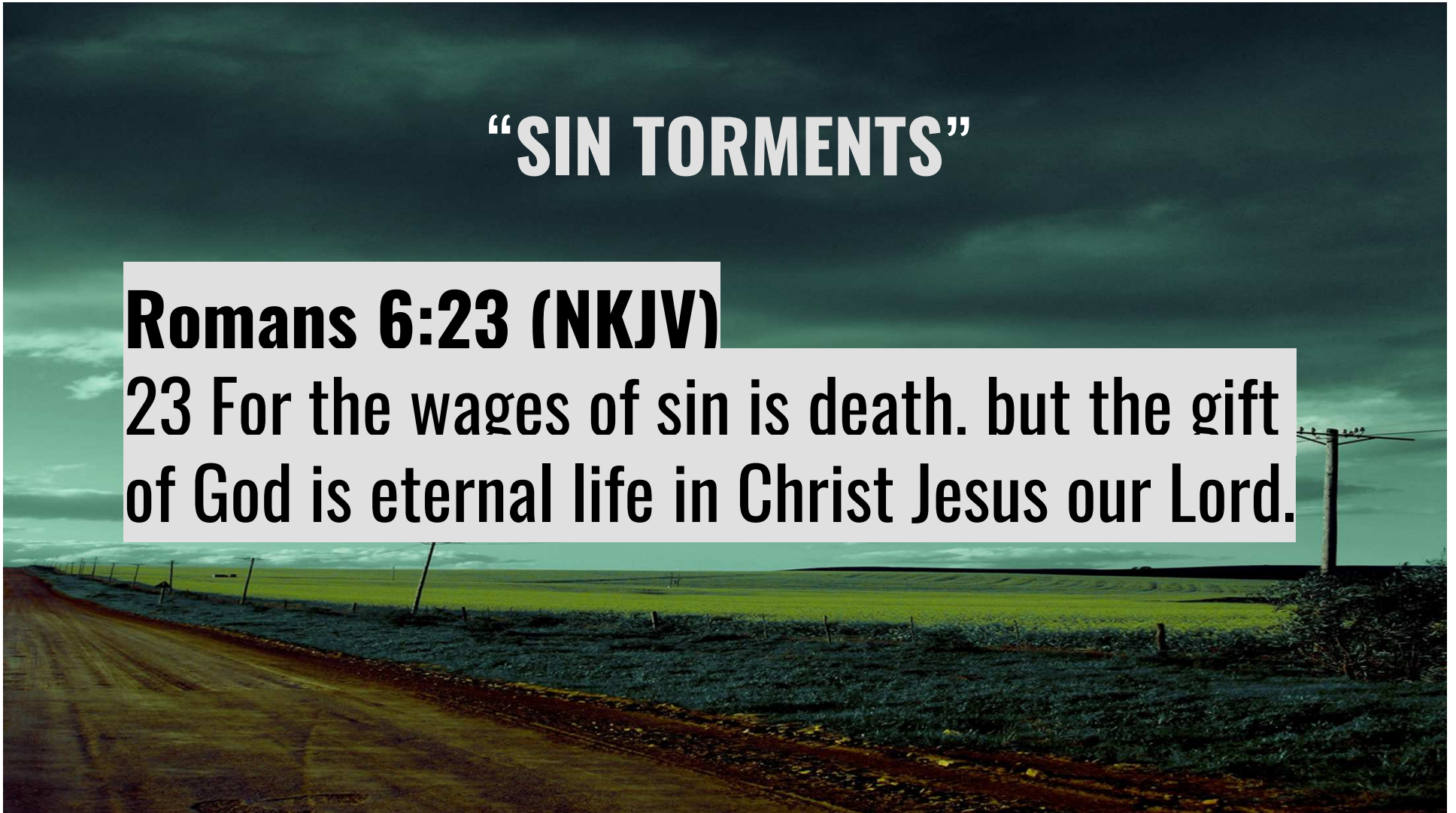

33 But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you






God gave us the Holy Spirit


2 Corinthians 5:14 (NKJV)
