2and every branch that bears fruit He prunes, that it may bear more fruit....8 By this My Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit; so you will be My disciples.


Hebrews 12:6 (NKJV)

PASSIONATE ABOUT A BIG


John 5:27 ESV
