






**To glorify God is a command**  
*Psalm 22:23 You who fear the LORD, praise him! All you offspring of Jacob, glorify him, and stand in awe of him, all you offspring of Israel!*




**To glorify God is due to Him**  
1Chronicles 16:29  
Ascribe to the LORD the glory due his name; bring an offering and come before him! Worship the LORD in the splendor of holiness;




**Isaiah 6:3**  
And one cried to another and said, Holy, holy, holy is the Lord of hosts; the whole earth is full of His glory!




**Psalm 145:3**  
Great is the LORD, and greatly to be praised, and his greatness is unsearchable.






**Romans 11:36**  
For from him and through him and to him are all things. To him be glory forever. Amen.






**Acts 17:24**  
The God who made the world and everything in it, being Lord of heaven and earth, does not live in temples made by man, <sup>25</sup>nor is he served by human hands, as though he needed anything, since he himself gives to all mankind life and breath and everything.



**1Corinthians 10:31**  
So, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God.



**Romans 1:21**  
and says, "For although they knew God, they did not honor (the word is "glorify," *doxasan*) him as God or give thanks to him."  
Verse 23 gives the answer: They "exchanged the *glory* of the immortal God for images."



**Romans 2:24**  
"For, as it is written, 'The name of God is blasphemed among the Gentiles because of you.'"  
**Romans 3:23**  
"For all have sinned and fall short of [literally, lack] the glory of God."

**1Corinthians 6:19-20**

Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God? You are not your own, <sup>20</sup> for you were bought with a price. So glorify God in your body.

**Romans 5:1-2**

Therefore, since we have been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. <sup>2</sup> Through him we have also obtained access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and we rejoice in hope of the glory of God.
