**Romans 2:1**

<sup>1</sup> Therefore you are inexcusable,  
 O man, whoever you are who  
judge, for in whatever you judge  
 another you condemn yourself;  
 for you who judge practice the  
 same things.

**Romans 2:3-5**

<sup>3</sup> And do you think this, O man,  
 you who judge those practicing  
 such things, and doing the same,  
 that you will escape the judgment  
 of God? <sup>4</sup> Or do you despise the  
riches of His goodness,  
 forbearance,

**James 4:11-12**

<sup>11</sup> Do not speak evil of one another, brethren. He who speaks evil of a brother and judges his brother, speaks evil of the law and judges the law. But if you judge the law, you are not a doer of the law

**James 4:11-12**

but a judge. <sup>12</sup> There is one Lawgiver, who is able to save and to destroy. Who are you to judge another?

**James 2:13**
