


The wall of Fame (Faith)
Genesis 6: 6-9 (NKJV)

- ⁸ But Noah found grace in the eyes of the LORD.
- ⁹ This is the genealogy of Noah. Noah was a just man, perfect in his generations. **Noah walked with God.**


Genesis 6: 9 (AMP)

- ⁹Noah was a just *and* righteous man, blameless *in* his [evil] generation; **Noah walked [in habitual fellowship] with God.**



The wall of Fame (Faith)
Hebrews 11:5-7 (NKJV)

- ⁵ By faith Enoch was taken away so that he did not see death, “and was not found, because God had taken him”; for before he was taken he had this testimony, that he pleased God.
- ⁶ **But without faith it is impossible to please *Him***, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and *that* He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek




The wall of Fame (Faith)
Hebrews 11:5-6 (NKJV)

- ⁷ By faith Noah, being divinely warned of **things not yet seen**, moved with godly fear, prepared an ark for the saving of his household, by which he condemned the world and became heir of the righteousness which is according to faith.



The wall of Fame (Faith)
By Faith these men walked with God.

2 Corinthians 5:7 For we **walk** by faith, not by sight.



Flesh vs Spirit
Galatians 3:2-5 (NKJV)

- ² This only I want to learn from you: Did you receive the Spirit by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith?
- ³ Are you so foolish? **Having begun in the Spirit, are you now being made perfect by the flesh?**
- ⁴ Have you suffered so many things in vain—if indeed it was in vain?



Flesh vs Spirit
Galatians 3:2-5 (NKJV)

- ⁵ Therefore He who supplies the Spirit to you and works miracles among you, does He do it by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith?—



Flesh vs Spirit
Galatians 3:3 (AMP)


³ Are you so foolish *and* so senseless *and* so silly? Having begun [your new life spiritually] with the [Holy] Spirit, are you now reaching perfection [by dependence] on the flesh?



Live by faith

Romans 1:16-17 (NKJV)

- ¹⁶ For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek.
- ¹⁷ For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from **faith to faith**; as it is written, "**The just shall live by faith.**"




Faith = God's grace = empower
Obedience

Without faith Enoch and Noah could not access God's grace, without His grace we can do nothing.

It is God's grace, which is God's power in us that empowers us to overcome

- not us ourselves
- We cannot.

Obedience

Romans 5: 1-2

- 5:¹ Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ,
- ² through whom also we have **access by faith into this grace** in which we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God.

Obedience

2 Corinthians 12:9

- ⁹ And He said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness." Therefore most gladly I will rather boast in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.
