



1 – A choice


2 – An inheritance or a birth right

Deuteronomy 5:16


16 "Honour your father and your mother, as the LORD your God commanded you, that your days may be long, and that it may go well with you in the land that the LORD your God is giving you.


Prodigal son

13 Not many days later, the younger son gathered all he had and took a journey into





15 So he went and hired himself out to one of the citizens of that country, who sent him into his fields to



17 "But when he came to himself, he said, 'How many of my father's hired servants have more than enough bread, but I perish here with hunger!





20 And he arose and came to his father. But while he



21 And the son said to him, 'Father, I have sinned against heaven and before you. I am no longer worthy to be called your son.'




