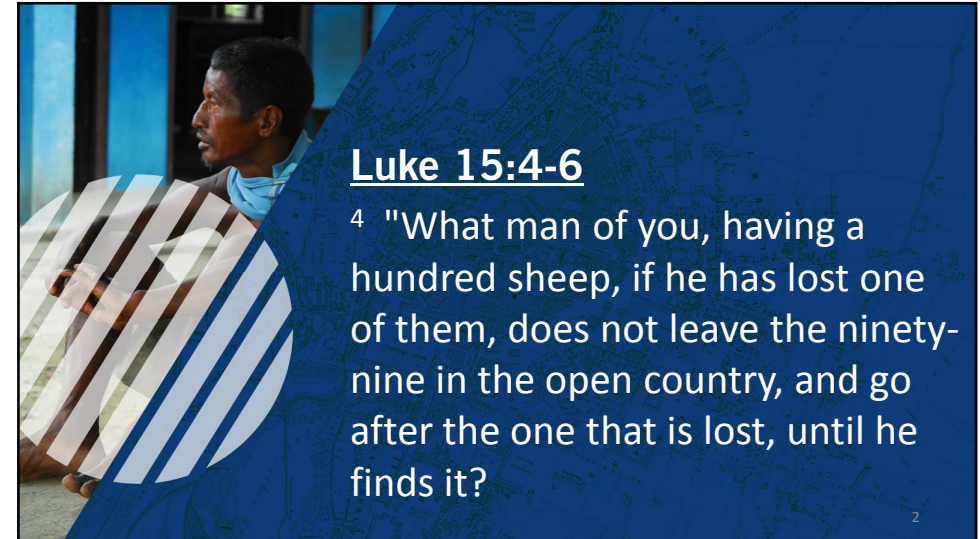


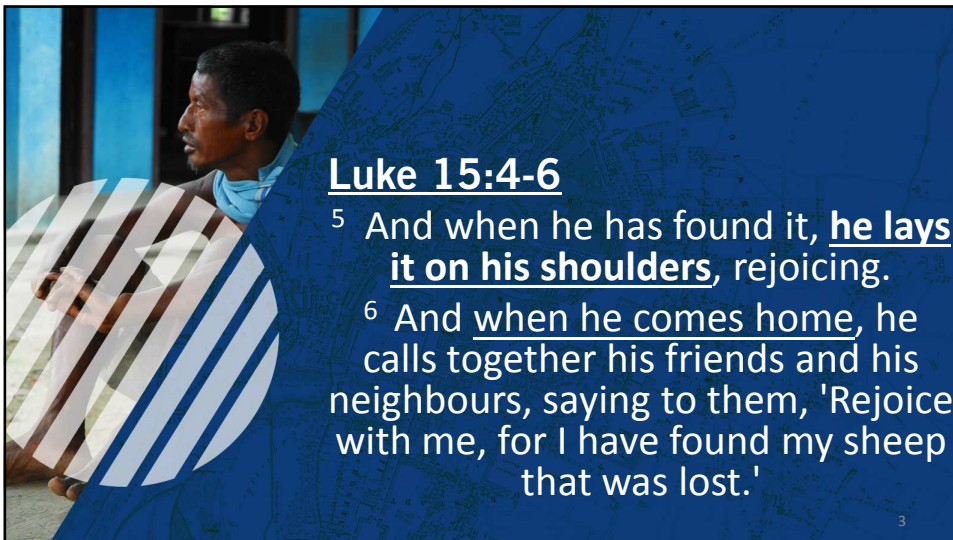


Calling for sons


⁵ And when he has found it, he lays it on his shoulders, rejoicing.


Luke 15:8-10




